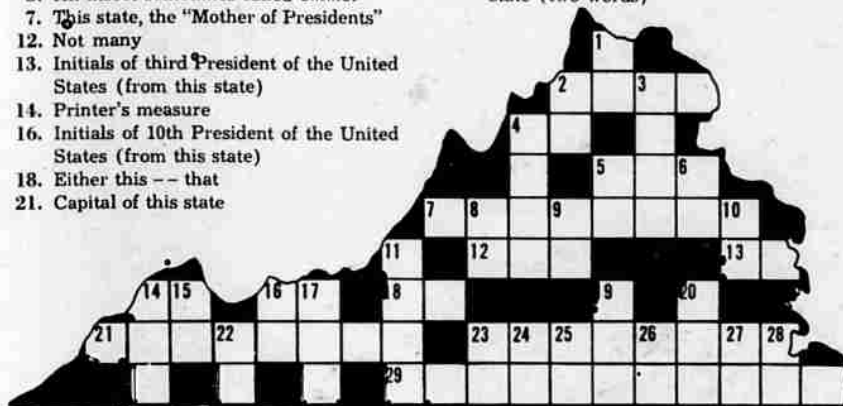

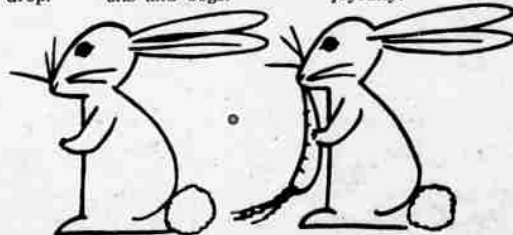
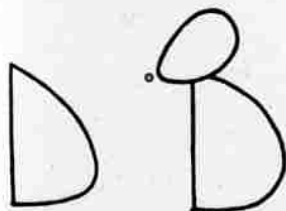
Let's Draw a Rabbit By Ann Davidow
