

Lakeview Roundup Plays Packed Stands; Gate Best Since 1956

LAKEVIEW—One of the most successful shows in many years was reported in the 42nd annual Lakeview Roundup with nearly packed stands for every performance. The report of Pat Cosgrove, treasurer, showed that the gate receipts were the largest since 1956.



SALEM (AP)—Oregon Tax Judge Peter Gunnar Saturday announced the names of all members of a drafting committee to work out rules for the regular division of the newly created court.

This division is where the major tax disputes involving larger sums of money that do not qualify for the small claims division will be tried.

Ralph R. Bailey previously was named chairman and Charles P. Duffy, vice chairman of the group.

Justice Hall S. Lusk of the Oregon Supreme Court and Judge Herbert M. Schwab of Multnomah County Circuit Court will advise the committee.

The target date for the initial draft of regulations is Oct. 15.

First Baby In 13 Tries

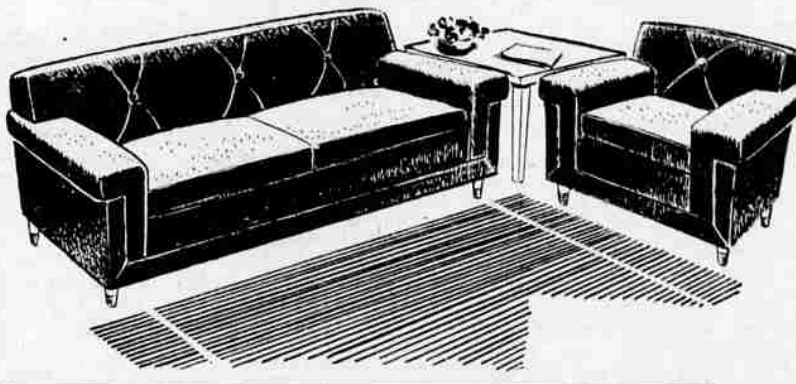

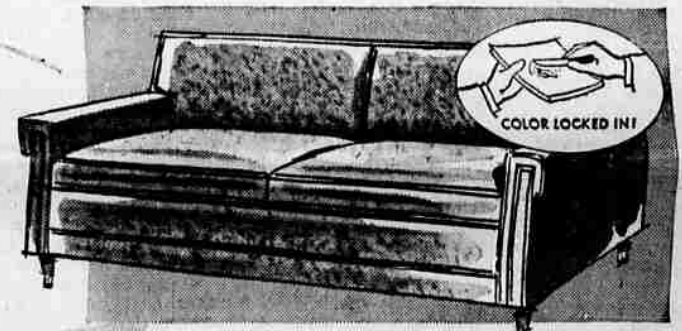
