

## SAMOS Spy Satellite Blows, Burns On Pad

POINT ARGUELLO, Calif. (UPI)—A SAMOS spy satellite blew up in three rumbling explosions Saturday when the Air Force attempted to launch it into an orbit that would have taken it over Russia.

The big Atlas booster with the 22-foot globe-circling satellite burst into flames. A massive wall of fire enveloping the launch pad at this Navy missile base 170 miles northwest of Los Angeles.

About 20 minutes after the explosion the Air Force, charged with the SAMOS program, announced that there were no injuries. Firemen moved in on the blaze and extinguished it quickly.

Witnesses at the press site said

that everything appeared normal seconds before the scheduled 12:20 p.m. PDT launch. Fire developed in the tail as the launching buttons were pushed, then the first explosion rocketed a huge cloud of black smoke high into the sky.

The SAMOS, billed as the replacement for the U2 spy plane, is designed to circle the earth in a continuous picture-taking tour. Today's launch was to have been the third in the SAMOS series. Of the two previous SAMOS shots, one went into orbit and the other did not although it did leave its pad.

## Funeral Home Strike Asked

PORTLAND (AP)—Union embalmers are asking the AFL-CIO to authorize a strike against Portland's funeral homes.

Business agent Paul Paulson of the Oregon Funeral Directors, Embalmers and Assistants Association said they are seeking a 15 per cent increase to bring their wages into line "with other professionals, such as accountants."

They now are paid \$504 monthly for 48 hours weekly on day shift and for 72 hours on nights. Paulson said the men also want a five-day, 40-hour week. He added that the morticians' association has offered a 4 per cent increase but no reduction in hours.

## CD Program Inadequate

STOWE, Vt. (AP)—A Cornell University physicist said Friday the U.S. civil defense program is "inadequate to meet the question of long-term survival."

Dr. Jay Dreier said fallout shelters provided protection against lethal radiation. "But what do you do after you crawl out of your shelter?" he asked. "How do you find food, water, fuel and other essentials?"

Dreier called for creation of community storage depots which would hold a year's supply of food and water.

He told newsmen at the Seventh Conference on Science and World Affairs that the "safest precaution against nuclear war is to leave the country."

A specialist in the hazards of nuclear fallout, Dreier said he doesn't own a fallout shelter and that neither do any of the physicists he knows.

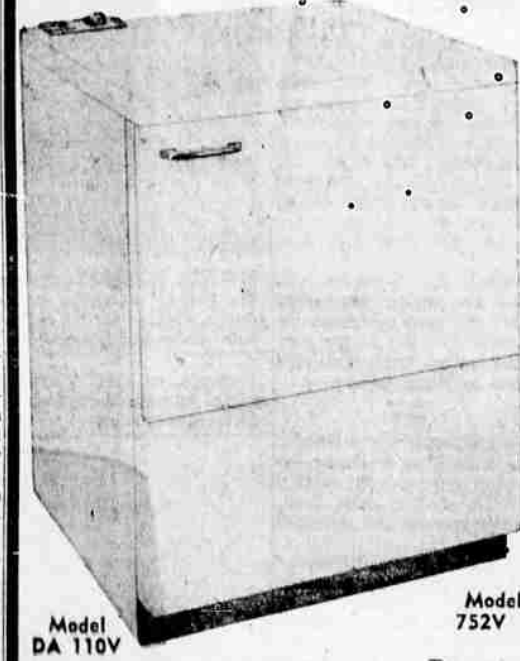
