

# Pistol Pete's Last Wish Granted Today

STUART, Fla. (AP) — Pistol Pete Butler will get his last wish today—to be buried on the range where he rode as a top cowhand for so many years.

The wiry little Negro—his real name was Will Butler but he was better known as Pistol Pete—was struck by an automobile on U.S. 1 two miles south of Stuart early Saturday and died later in a West Palm Beach hospital.

Nobody knew his real age, but rancher William J. Matheson estimates Pistol Pete was over 80. He was drafted in World War I but was discharged because he was over age, said Matheson. That was 44 years ago.

Pistol Pete came from Texas, where he acquired his love of horses and the life of a cowboy. "He was a good hand," said Matheson. "For the 20 years he rode herd on our cattle he was close to the family."

Like most cowhands, Pistol Pete made a regular weekend sortie to the county seat.

"He would leave the ranch every Friday evening and come back early Saturday morning," Matheson said. "That's the only time he left the ranch."

The Matheson family and the ranch hands are giving Pistol Pete the kind of funeral any cowboy would want. The body will be brought to the ranch from a funeral home in Fort Pierce.

It will lie in state in the Matheson living room from 1 to 2 p.m. Then six pallbearers—three white and three Negro—will take the body to the grave out in the pasture, in the shade of a clump of pines, where Pistol Pete often said he wanted to be buried.

# ShIPLEY Murder Trial Opens In Coast City

NEWPORT, Ore. (AP) — The first degree murder trial of Larry West Shipley, 20, McMinnville, opened Tuesday with the selection of a jury of six men and six women.

Scheduled for this morning was the selection of alternate jurors. After that, the jury was to make a trip to the spot near Otis Junction, some 20 miles north of Newport, where Linda Jean Stevens, 16, was shot and killed five weeks ago.

Shipley is accused of the slaying, along with Glenn Dixon, 18, McMinnville. Dixon's trial will start Oct. 10.

Few prospective jurors were challenged Tuesday. Most of the persons dismissed from duty were women.

The defense attorney for Shipley is E.K. Richardson, Newport, who was appointed by the court.

# Pleads Guilty To Mail Fraud

PORTLAND (AP) — Mrs. Le-lan A. Deegan, 24, Bend, and Larry Warren Haynes, 28, Portland, accused of mail fraud, pleaded guilty to the charges against them in U.S. District Court Tuesday.

This left eleven other persons to be tried on charges of using the mails to defraud insurance companies.

Mrs. Deegan's husband and George James Barnard, 47, Portland, were arrested Sept. 3 on charges of intimidating witnesses in the case.

# Navy Warships Engage In Hurricane Mercy Mission

 PENSACOLA, Fla. (AP) — Navy warships head for a peacetime mercy mission on the devastated Texas coast today, carrying doctors and helicopters instead of soldiers and jet fighters.

The ships—two aircraft carriers, two destroyers and a transport—hope to reach the ravaged Texas coastlands of Hurricane Carla by first light Thursday. All are part of Task Force 135, commanded by Rear Adm. F. J. Brush.

Some 50 military doctors, four nurses and 40 helicopters were to join the carriers Shangri-la and Antietam early today at Pensacola. The carriers also will carry emergency supplies, including hundreds of disposable diapers, nursing bottles and baby food.

The destroyers Compton and Gainard and the transport Francis Marion were under full steam to the disaster scene.

Blue jacket landing force parties to augment the Marines are on both the carriers and destroyers.

Lt. George W. Milland, the Shangri-la's medical administrative officer, said the carriers can be converted to hospitals.

"We're prepared to take aboard pregnant women, old people and babies," he said.

"We can take over the whole ship, if necessary. That's 3,000 beds, plus over 1,000 cots on board to set up on the hangar bay."

The transport can act as a floating hotel, taking aboard hurricane victims who do not need medical care. Over 2,300 beds are available.

Twenty-seven of the helicopters are Marine troop transport helicopters, equipped with hoists, ladders, and capable of 12-person loads. They flew in to Pensacola Tuesday with 60 pilots and over 100 crewmen.

The landing force commander is Lt. Col. L. E. Midkiff of Salt Rock, W.Va. He will work with Brush and the 8th Naval District commandant in New Orleans.
