NEW YORK (AP) — The stock market showed sharp losses late this afternoon after a burst of selling greeted news of the death of U.N. Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjöld.

Volume for the day was estimated at 3.5 million shares compared with 3.1 million Friday. Key stocks were down from fractions to 1 or 2 points. More volatile issues showed wider losses.
