

Top Educators To Speak Here

Three "top brass" of Oregon education, including State Superintendent Dr. Leon Minear, will speak in Klamath Falls Sept. 23 to combined representatives of the area's three school boards.

Besides Dr. Minear, J. L. Turnbull, deputy superintendent, and Thomas Rigby, executive secretary of the Oregon School Board Association, will speak at the dinner meeting slated for the Pelican Grill.

Dr. Minear will deliver the key address to local educators and

board members. His topic will be how the State Department of Education can best serve the schools. A question and answer period will follow Minear's talk.

Rigby will lead off the program, which is scheduled for presentation across the state. His topic will be proposed changes in school finance. Turnbull will speak on "The Intermediate Unit," possible changes in the county school office.

The program during September will travel to Lakeview, Burns, Vale and Baker. It is scheduled for other cities in the state at later dates.

The no-host dinner will be held for \$2.50 per plate; the public and wives of board members and educators are invited. Reservations must be placed with Dr. C. H. Robinson, superintendent of county schools.

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Crescent Man Held In Jail

A 13-year-old girl, Jane Lois Zigler of Prineville, became Klamath County's 15th traffic fatality of the year last week when she died in a Bend hospital.

The girl died last Monday; state police learned, from injuries that she sustained Sept. 3 in a two-car crash on Highway 97 in the Gilchrist area.

State police said the girl had been a passenger in a car driven by her father, Donald S. Zigler, 49, when it collided with a car driven by David W. Flynn, 42, Gilchrist. Flynn, Zigler, Mrs. Zigler, 41, and another daughter, Carol, 17, were also injured and were treated at St. Charles Hospital in Bend.

Booked at the city jail was Cecil A. Low, 4329 Greensprings Drive. Low pleaded not guilty Monday morning in municipal court and asked for a jury trial.

Police were on patrol Saturday morning when they saw Charlie Schuss, owner of the Chuck Waggon Restaurant, 630 Main Street, walk out the front door of his place with a bloody face. They checked and Schuss told them that he had been struck by a man whom he had asked to leave.

Police found Low being restrained by some men in the bar. They said Low tried to attack Schuss again and had to be forced into the police car.

Two other men were charged the weekend. They were Charles J. Lalonde, 37, of 125 South Sixth Street, and Eugene A. Montgomery, 72, Chilcoquin. Police said they were fighting Saturday evening on Main Street between Sixth and Seventh streets.

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
