

Reapportionment Plan Would Cut Some Legislators

SALEM (AP) — Several veteran Oregon legislators would be reapportioned out of the Oregon legislature and others would be pitted against each other in the reapportionment plan announced Thursday.

The plan was prepared by Secretary of State Howell Appling Jr. The state Supreme Court ordered it after declaring a plan passed by the legislature unconstitutional.

The Appling plan, based on the court decision specifying that ap-

portionment follow population, reduced the number of Eastern Oregon senators from six to five. This would drop Sen. Loyd Key, D-Milwaukie, because his district would be combined with that of Sen. Dwight Hopkins, D-Imbler. Hopkins is a holdover and Key is not.

The district of Sen. Carl Francis, R-Dayton, would be expanded to give Washington a share in another senator so he would have to run in both Washington and Yamhill counties instead of just Yamhill as in the past.

The plan would combine Polk and Benton counties into one district so Sens. Francis Zeigler of Corvallis and Walter Leth of Salem, both Republicans, would have to run against each other to see who stays.

In the House of Representatives, Wasco and Hood River counties would be combined into one district which would pit Reps. Katherine Musa of The Dalles and George Annala of Hood River against each other if both wished to stay.

Reps. R. R. Raymond of Helix and Stafford Hansell of Hermiston, both Republicans; and Rep. Frank Weatherford, D-Ole-

would contest for two seats in a newly expanded district. The new district would include Umatilla, Morrow, Gilliam, Sherman and Wheeler counties. Before, Weatherford represented all but Umatilla and Raymond and Hansell represented Umatilla.

The two Klamath County representatives, Republicans George Filtrcraft and Carrol Howe, both Klamath Falls, would see their district expanded to include Lake County.

Reds Frown On Travel

BERLIN (AP) — Communist East Germany today accused U.S. forces in Berlin of grossly violating its air space by flying refugees out of Steinstuecken, which is West Berlin territory.

A spokesman for the East German Foreign Ministry called the evacuation Wednesday of seven refugees by two U.S. Army helicopters "an act of organized kidnapping."

"Only because of the utmost restraint shown by the organs of the German Democratic Republic was a serious incident avoided," the spokesman said. His statement was reported by the official East German news agency ADN.

The refugees had to be lifted over Communist territory because Steinstuecken—the hamlet the United States has made a symbol of Western rights in Berlin—is cut off from the rest of West Berlin.

The Communists made no attempt to interfere with the airlift Wednesday from the isolated enclave a mile beyond the border of West Berlin.

An Army spokesman said the helicopters were on a routine visit to Steinstuecken—a community of only 200 inhabitants—and agreed to fly the refugees to the West.
