JC's Extend Belt Drive

Klamath Jaycees have extended the current seat belt campaign to run through Oct. 29, Jaycees President Mel Campbell announced Tuesday.

The decision to extend and expand the program came as the local club learned that over 500 seat belts had been distributed to the two Klamath Falls outlets. Also in the offing is the addition of several new outlets for the belts. These will be marked with signs in the next few days, Campbell said.

Total sales on the campaign have amounted to more than 300 belts, the Jaycees estimate, both M.J.R. Muffler Shop on South Sixth Street and Dick's Richfield Service at Esplanade and Wall streets have full supplies of belts. Two types of seat belt are available: a fabric to metal type for \$4.75 per set which retails for \$7.95 and a metal to metal, quick release type for \$5.75 which retails normally for \$12.50. Both outlets are installing belts for \$1 per set.
