Lumber Wagon Injures Man

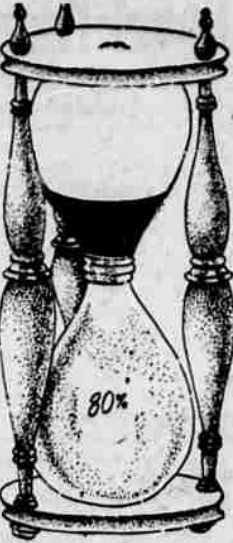
