a 22 mark, have finished OCC play and will take the weekend off.

A win for the Owls Saturday will level them off with a 2-2 mark and a defeat would do the same for the visitors. In that case PSC, OTI and OCE would each claim a share of the number two spot. The Raiders are rated a

strong favorite to handle the Mountaineers.

From a comparative score standpoint, using Southern Oregon in the comparison, the Techmen get the nod as the favorite here Saturday, but the intense rivalry between the Owls and the Wolves has proven over seasons past that comparisons do not win ball games.

The Owls were barely beaten,

6-0, by the Raiders while the Wolves suffered a humiliating 26-7 loss at the hands of the big Red.

Coach Bill McArthur's team is led by power-house ground-gainer Bob Pennel, one of the top rushers in the league.

The Owls have been working this week to make sure that their defenses, the best in the league for the OCC season, contain Pennel.

The Tech answer to the Pennel threat lies in fullback Stan Glass, who was bumped from the top of the OCC rushing heap when he was limited by a bad hand injury a few weeks back.

Joining Glass in the Owl offensive structure will be halfbacks Lanny Myers and Harvey Graham, and quarterback Bill Ransome.

No changes in the offensive plans are scheduled for the weekend, according to the Owl coaching staff, and the squad came through their bruising defeat at the hands of the Humboldt State Lumberjacks with no injuries.

The Owls got away with a narrow 26-20 victory the last time the two schools met, the 1960 contest being played on the Wolves' home grounds.

see them do away with the suspension type helmet—do away with the webbing and make it fit more snugly to the player's head. And also, cut down on the mask . . . this would increase the player's area of vision. With the protruding face mask and the 'suspension' helmet there is always a possibility of getting up inside the headgear and this can be dangerous.

"In regards to the NCAA's plan . . . I would like to see a much more extensive study undertaken before they decide. No reference has been made as yet as to the number of head injuries among the 26 deaths reported . . . and I think it is probable some are due to heat prostration, lack of training, conditioning, etc.

"Perhaps they can pinpoint the actual cause and then decide."

"This year is certainly not that of the average year. These things just happen, and this year has been a bad one. Last year there were a great deal fewer and I'm sure that next year things will be different again.

"In my 11 years of coaching I have had only two head injuries on my squads . . . and I've stuck with one maker of helmet throughout.

"The company that makes this gear spends a lot of time, money and research effort to determine the safest, most practical things for our players to use . . . and I'll have to go along with them.

"They've made improvements over the years . . . and they'll probably come up with some more. We don't use the 'suspension' type any more—and I'm satisfied with what we use now but if they modify the helmet again, we'll go with them.

"This type of helmet is used by the Air Force, race drivers, etc. . . . and it provides the maximum of protection.

"I want no part of the old leather helmet . . . they are just as hard . . . and they don't give the boy enough protection."

PLACED ON WAIVERS
HOUSTON, Tex. (UPI)—Byron Beams and Leo Reed have been placed on waivers by the Houston Oilers of the American Football League.

Bob Williams, Klamath Union football coach:
"I'm firmly in favor of both the plastic helmet, the type we use here, and the face mask. I'm convinced that if either of the two pieces of equipment are responsible for injuries—I'd have to say it was the mask. However, given my choice I'd want my players to use the masks. There's a lot of protection there for them — and after all, the helmet and mask were designed to protect the wearer.

"I'd like to make it clear, in face of all we have been reading, that the number of fatal injuries
