### End Asked For Patent Drug Laws

WASHINGTON (UPI)—An economist recommended to a Senate subcommittee today that patents for drugs be abolished.

Dr. Colston E. Warne, Amherst College (Mass.) economics professor, said no manufacturer should be given "monopolistic control" through patents over drugs which might be vital to the health of millions of persons.

"In the kind of life we live today," Warne said, "a drug can be as important as air and water. A drug is not a gadget."

The statement came in testimony prepared for the opening of another three days of hearings by the Senate Antitrust and Monopoly subcommittee on a proposed drug control bill.

The legislation is sponsored by subcommittee Chairman Estes Kefauver, D-Tenn., who has charged that ethical drug prices are "generally unreasonable and excessive."

Warne also is president of Consumers Union, of Mount Vernon, N.Y., a non-profit group which tests consumer products and issues the monthly magazine consumer reports with a 950,000 circulation.

Warne said manufacturers of prescription drugs had abused the patent system by "jiggling the names in the molecular chemical composition," while "charging exorbitant prices" for supposedly "new" drugs.

Asks Patent Abolishment. He said the patent provisions of the Kefauver bill did not go far enough. The bill calls for exclusive rights to patents on drugs to be reduced from the present 17 to three years. It also would require a patent holder to license any other manufacturer for the remaining 14 years in return for a 3 per cent royalty.

Warne termed these features "an unsatisfactory halfway house . . ."

He recommended that the bill be altered "so as to eliminate completely patent protection in the field of drugs."

### Jet Hijacker Given Life

EL PASO, Tex. (UPI) — Leon Bearden, 38, was sentenced to life plus 25 years in federal prison today for hijacking a Continental Airlines jetliner Aug. 3.

Bearden received near maximum punishment for violating three federal laws in the hijacking. His son, Cody, 16, who pleaded guilty to similar charges, was sentenced to an undesignated federal institution until he is 21.

A federal court jury found the elder Bearden guilty Oct. 18 of kidnaping, interstate transportation of a stolen airplane and obstruction of interstate commerce.

The plane, en route from Los Angeles to Houston, Tex., was hijacked between Phoenix and El Paso. The Beardens said they intended to take the craft to Cuba and sell it.

The pilot told the Beardens he didn't have enough fuel to fly to Cuba and got permission to stop at El Paso. When Bearden ordered the pilot to take off from El Paso for Cuba, Border Patrol agents shot out the tires and one engine of the plane as it taxied toward the runway.

A few hours later border patrolmen and FBI agents boarded the plane, overcame the Beardens and took them prisoner.

### Reds Remove Stalin Name

MOSCOW (UPI)—Soviet workmen today began removing Stalin's name from the Red Square tomb which now will belong to Lenin alone.

The work began late today after the 22nd Communist Party Congress voted to move the former Soviet dictator's body from the tomb to an undisclosed location.

It is assumed here that Stalin's remains may already have been removed via an underground tunnel from the tomb to the Kremlin.

About 600 Soviet citizens gathered on Red Square in the chilly dark of this late fall evening to watch the final act of humiliation for Stalin.

Working behind a wooden fence put up at some distance from the tomb, the workmen busily chipped and hammered on the red and black marble nameplate which carries the name of both Lenin and Stalin.

It was assumed the work was being speeded so a new nameplate with only Lenin's name would be in place when Premier Nikita Khrushchev and other Soviet leaders mount the mausoleum Nov. 7 to watch the giant parade honoring the anniversary of the Russian Revolution.
