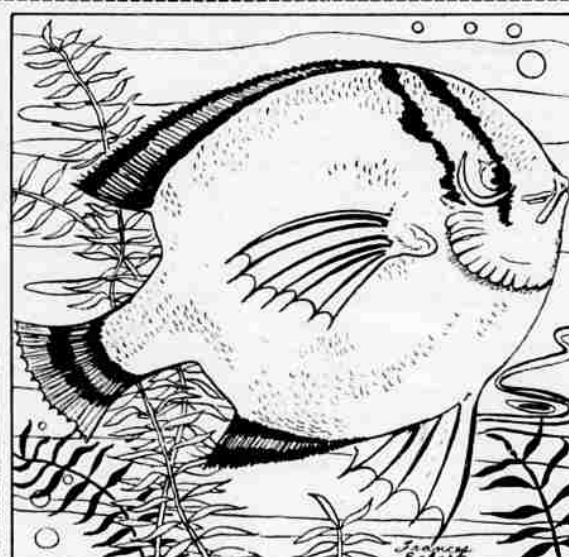
SPECIAL COLORING CONTEST—What Fish Is It?
