

135 Bird Species Noted In Klamath Basin Area During Nature Society's Nine-Day Observing Period

Species of birds numbering 135 were noted in the Klamath Basin during the nine-day observing period conducted by the Nature Society from Oct. 14-22. This was the third extensive check on bird species to be made this year and covers the bird life present in the Klamath Basin during the height of the fall migration season. This is the largest number of species observed during the month of October during the past four years. In 1958 the tally was 128 species; 1959 saw 102 species, 1960 produced a report of 120 species. The species noted were: eared grebe, western grebe, pied-billed grebe, white pelican, double-crested cormorant, great blue heron, common egret, snowy egret, black-crowned night heron, whistling swan, Canada goose, lesser Canada goose, cackling goose, white-fronted goose, lesser snow goose, Ross's goose, mallard, gadwall,

intail, green-winged teal, cinnamon teal, shoveller, redhead, canvas-back, lesser scaup, common golden-eye, Barrow's golden-eye, buffle-head, ruddy duck, common merganser. Turkey vulture, Cooper's hawk, red-tailed hawk, Swainson's hawk, rough-legged hawk, golden eagle, bald eagle, marsh hawk, prairie falcon, pigeon hawk, sparrow hawk, sage hen, California quail, ring-necked pheasant, sandhill crane, Virginia rail, coot, semipalmated plover, killdeer, common snipe, greater yellow-legs, lesser yellow-legs, knot, dowitcher, western sandpiper, avocet, northern phalarope, California gull, ring-billed gull, Forrester's tern, black tern. Rock dove, western mourning dove, barn owl, horned owl, pygmy owl, belted kingfisher, red-shafted flicker, Lewis's woodpecker,

red-naped sapsucker, red-breasted sapsucker, hairy woodpecker, downy woodpecker, black-backed 3-toed woodpecker, western kingbird, horned lark, tree swallow, barn swallow, cliff swallow, gray jay, Steller's jay, scrub jay, black-billed magpie, raven, crow, pinon jay, Clark's nutcracker. Black-capped chickadee, mountain chickadee, plain titmouse, bush-tit, white-breasted nuthatch, pygmy nuthatch, brown creeper, dipper, marsh wren, rock wren, robin, hermit thrush (Sierra), Mexican bluebird, mountain bluebird, Townsend's solitaire, golden-crowned kinglet, ruby-crowned kinglet, water pipit, cedar waxwing, loggerhead shrike, starling, myrtle warbler, Audubon's warbler, house sparrow, western meadowlark, yellow-headed blackbird, red-wing, tricolored red-wing, Brewer's blackbird, brown-headed cowbird.

Purple finch, Cassin's purple finch, house finch, pine siskin, American goldfinch, lesser goldfinch, spotted towhee, Savannah sparrow, Oregon junco, white-crowned sparrow, Gambel's white-crown, golden-crowned sparrow, Alberta fox sparrow, Modoc song sparrow, Merrill's song sparrow. The area covered by this report takes in all of the Upper Klamath Basin from Crater Lake and the Klamath Marsh to the Modoc Lava Beds. Neal G. Grand Jury Gets Theft Case Involving 2 Youths

Two Klamath Falls youths, both 18, have been bound over to the grand jury on charges of burglary not in a dwelling following district court preliminary hearings.

Judge Hal F. Coe decided there was sufficient evidence to submit the cases involving Steve E. Taylor, 2853 Front Street, and Samuel A. Herrera, 3823 Crest Street, to the grand jury. Both youths are accused of breaking into the Moose Lodge, 1010 Pine Street, early on Oct. 27 and stealing some whiskey, candy and cigarettes.

Taylor's preliminary hearing was Monday while Herrera's was Tuesday afternoon. Witnesses at both hearings included City Juvenile Officer Ray Howard, Moose official Ervin Carr and a 17-year-old youth. The youth testified that Taylor didn't enter the building. Carr said 50 bottles of whisky were stolen and Howard said that Herrera admitted stealing 13 bottles.

Lebold, the board said, was hit with a sock containing some small paint jars. He was able to get the boys back into bed before help arrived.

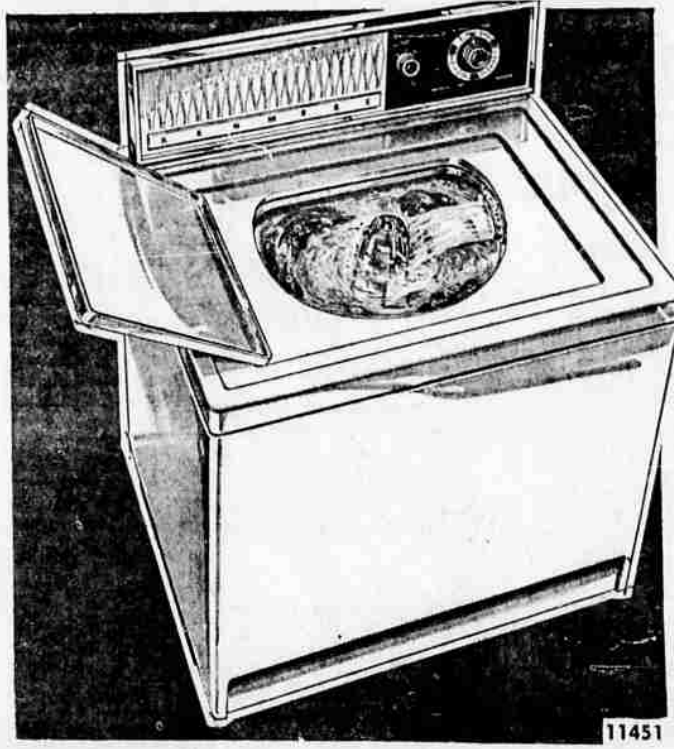

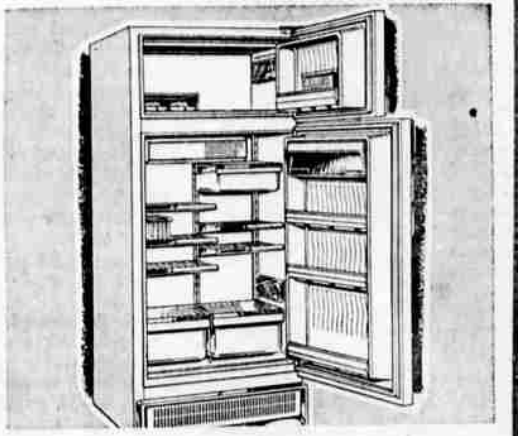
