

Bonds Slash Road Funds, Says Jackson

NEWPORT (UPI) — Glenn L. Jackson, Medford, chairman of the Oregon Highway Commission, said today he hopes the legislature doesn't authorize any more highway bonds, because the interest payments eat into regular highway funds.

The 1963-65 budget approved by the commission today includes \$17.6 million for bond retirement, the third largest item in the overall budget.

Jackson said Oregon at present has sufficient matching money for federal aid projects "but this situation could become critical if more bonds are authorized by the legislature."
