

# Hoffa Testifies For Self

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (UPI) — The government contends Hoffa and Brennan shared in a \$1 million payoff from Commercial Carriers Inc. Detroit trucking firm. Hoffa and Brennan were paid off to keep labor peace for Commercial and Test Fleet Inc., a firm set up here. The wives of Hoffa and Brennan owned the stock in Test Fleet in their maiden names.

Hoffa began his testimony as the trial was nearing the end of its eighth week.

Hoffa denied owning J. and H. Sales and Equipment Corp. which the government contends was the predecessor to a firm set up to allegedly pay off Hoffa and the late Owen Brennan, another teamsters leader.

Hoffa said originally his intention had been to own J. and H. but that he and Brennan decided it would be "a good thing" for their wives to have independent incomes in case something happened to Hoffa and Brennan.

## Truck Driver Escapes Dive

SUPERIOR, Mont. (UPI) — A truck driver narrowly missed hurtling 150 feet into the Clark Fork river early Friday when his truck-trailer skidded into a bridge rail five miles west of Alberton in Western Montana.

The driver, Frank W. Baul, 47, of Tigard, Ore., suffered only minor cuts and bruises when he was thrown from the cab of the vehicle, over the guard rail and about 10 feet to the ground.

# Jackie Kennedy Visits Institution

WASHINGTON (UPI)—The children of Junior Village, a Washington institution for the homeless, swarmed eagerly around the smiling lady wearing the Christmas red suit Thursday.

Her name was Jacqueline Kennedy, and her visit had an official purpose: To call attention to overcrowded conditions in the home.

Public duty gave way quickly to private sympathies, as the first lady succumbed to the charm and plight of the small charges.

She bore a large basket filled with toys and candy, and her schedule called for their distribution at the end of the visit. But the schedule crumbled when a

small boy, his voice edged with disappointment, asked, "Didn't you bring us anything?"

Jackie immediately jettisoned the schedule and began handing out the candy and toys. Climbing on table tops, waving their hands and shouting with glee, the tykes emptied the basket in a matter of minutes.

The first lady's itinerary called also for a brief visit. That too was forgotten as she talked to the children, dispensed cheerful words to the sick and viewed a small boy's drawing. "It's very pretty," she told him.

The youngsters responded to Mrs. Kennedy's Christmas gesture with a rendition of "Silent Night, Holy Night."

President Kennedy, at his news conference Wednesday, had called for Congress to give the institution more attention.

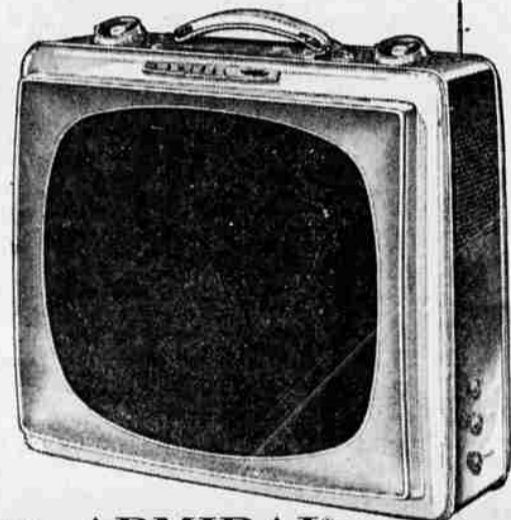

# Wheat Plan Supported

DENVER (UPI)—A committee of the National Association of Wheat Growers backed the administration wheat program Thursday and Agriculture Secretary Orville Freeman said the American Farm Bureau Federation was a "minority of one" in opposing it.

The NAWG committee on national programs urged delegates attending the 13th annual convention to urge by resolution that wheat farmers approve the proposed 1964 program in next spring's referendum.

The administration program would assault the U. S. wheat glut by cutting acreage allotments 15 to 20 per cent and increasing support prices.

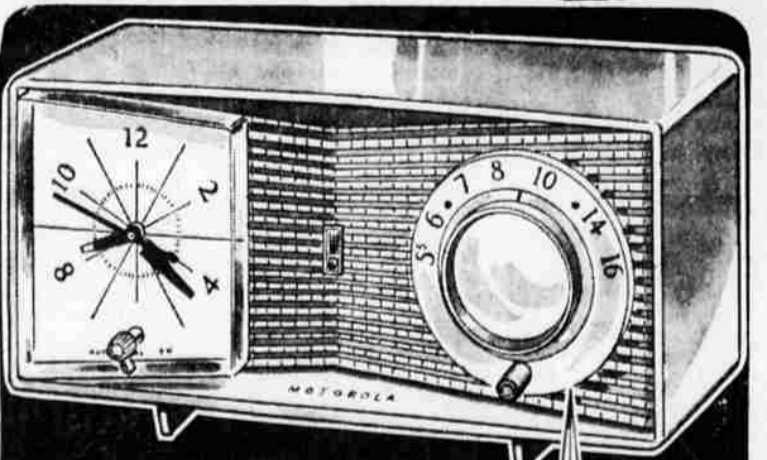
In a speech to the convention Thursday Freeman said a no vote would cause a disastrous drop in wheat prices and encourage international trade barrier juggling harmful to the free world.
