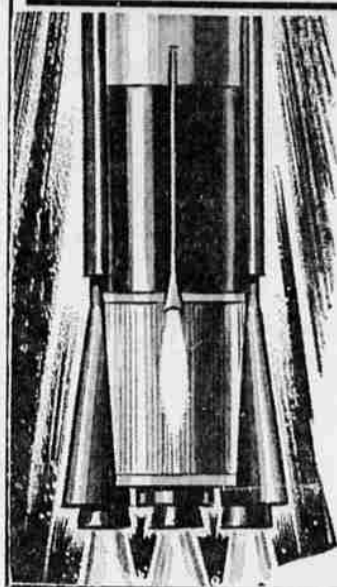

## State Capitol Readies Inaugural Ceremonies

SALEM (UPI)—Protocol in the inaugural ceremonies here Monday will take a slight shift from previous years.

The superintendent of public instruction, who until 1961 was a statewide elected official, no longer will be in the processional.

His position will be taken by tax court Judge Peter Gunnar who is a statewide elected official.

And what a forthcoming chief for Mrs. Hatfield! In a four day period she entertains the entire legislature at the Hatfield home, takes in the inaugural affairs, begins her weekly "at homes" for the public, and observes another birthday—her 34th.

The state's four living former governors are expected to attend the inaugural ceremonies. They are Charles A. Sprague, John Hall, Elmo Smith and Robert Holmes.

which came in four years ago reduced the number of seats on the north and south aisles.

However this inauguration will probably be seen by more people than any in Oregon history, thanks to television. Not only are there more stations in Oregon, but ambitious coverage plans call for 12 cameras in the House chambers Monday when the gavel opens the 32nd legislative assembly.

The governor won't be using a teleprompter on his expected 45-minute inaugural address. He used one last time and it stopped in mid-speech. He had backstopped himself with a typed manuscript and was able to go on without interruption.

Chief Justice William M. McAllister, a former speaker of the House, will be swearing in Hatfield for the third time. He did the honors for Hatfield as secretary of state and last time as governor.

To accommodate the planned five television coverage, the House will be sworn in at 10 a.m. and the Senate at 10:15 a.m.

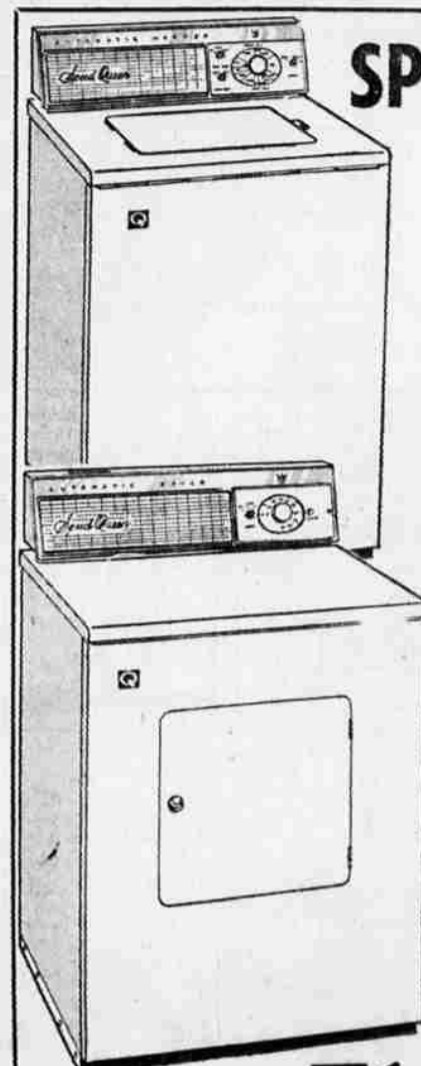
