# No Help For Reds Seen In French Action

PARIS (UPI) — If Soviet Premier Nikita S. Khrushchev hopes to cash in on the present turmoil in the Western camp he will get no help from French President Charles de Gaulle.

Talk of a "Paris-Moscow axis" has made headlines since De Gaulle blew up the Common Market negotiations in Brussels last Tuesday.

It was fanned by a visit paid by Soviet Ambassador Sergei Vinogradov to De Gaulle the same evening. Khrushchev himself added to the speculation by claiming this week De Gaulle had told him France is not interested in Berlin.

Announcement of a new French-Soviet trade pact in Moscow Friday was interpreted as a further sign.

But aides, who should know, say nothing in fact is further from De Gaulle's mind than a deal with the Russians now at the expense of the Western alliance.

**Kremlin Concerned**

According to the best available information Vinogradov himself asked to see De Gaulle to voice the Kremlin's concern about the treaty of alliance signed recently by De Gaulle and West German Chancellor Konrad Adenauer.

There was no mention of a possible Paris - Moscow deal, the sources said.

As for De Gaulle's purported statement to Khrushchev, observers here are skeptical he ever made it. In any case, they said there had been no direct contact between the two since Khrushchev's Paris visit in 1960.

Finally, the trade treaty between the French and Russians had been in the works for months. The fact it was signed this week was no indication of De Gaulle playing footsie-footsie with the Kremlin, French officials insist.

In fact, all the talk of a "Paris-Moscow axis," as with similar rumors of a "Paris-Madrid axis" in the making, has annoyed French officials.

Sources close to De Gaulle insist "his hostility to communism is as great as it ever has been."

**Still For Alliance**

French sources also said De Gaulle was still convinced of the need of a strong Western alliance and cited the fact that in the Cuban crisis De Gaulle told Kennedy France would be in any war on the American side if the United States became involved in a war with Russia.

French officials said De Gaulle believes that in the long run Russia will throw its lot in with the rest of Europe. He sees

Russia as mellowing and becoming gradually less rabidly Communist while the West becomes more "socialist."

He believes the rift with Communist China will speed this process.

French officials also have pooh-poohed the idea of a Paris-Madrid axis despite an obvious strengthening of ties between the two countries.

## South Must Take Trick

The Card School in New York is a partnership of three of the country's best bridge players who are united together to teach instead of to play bridge. Peter Lev-entritt is a member of this year's American team which will compete for the World's Championship this summer. Boris Koytchou and Edgar Kaplan each have won numerous titles. All have been good partners of mine on occasion and tough opponents at other times.

They do most of their teaching through sample hands and this week's series will deal with some of them.

North and South have no trouble getting to four hearts and South should easily make the contract.

He wins the spade opening and notes that he has two potential spade losers and must also lose the ace of clubs and hearts. He has to do something about one of those spade losers and there is a convenient place to park one. South must lead his queen of diamonds and overtake with dummy's king. Then he can discard one spade loser on the ace of diamonds and go about the business of knocking out the ace of trumps. There is a natural disinclination to waste the potential trick represented by that queen, but South must overcome his. If he doesn't overtake he will wind up with the ace and king of diamonds in dummy and no way to use them.
