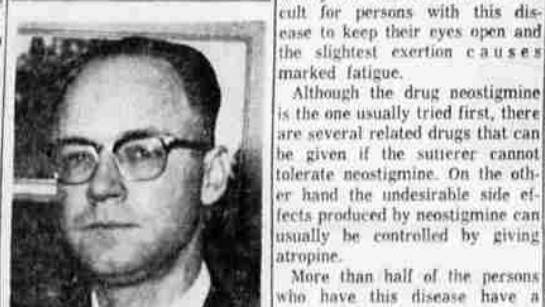
Fred Taylor Appointed

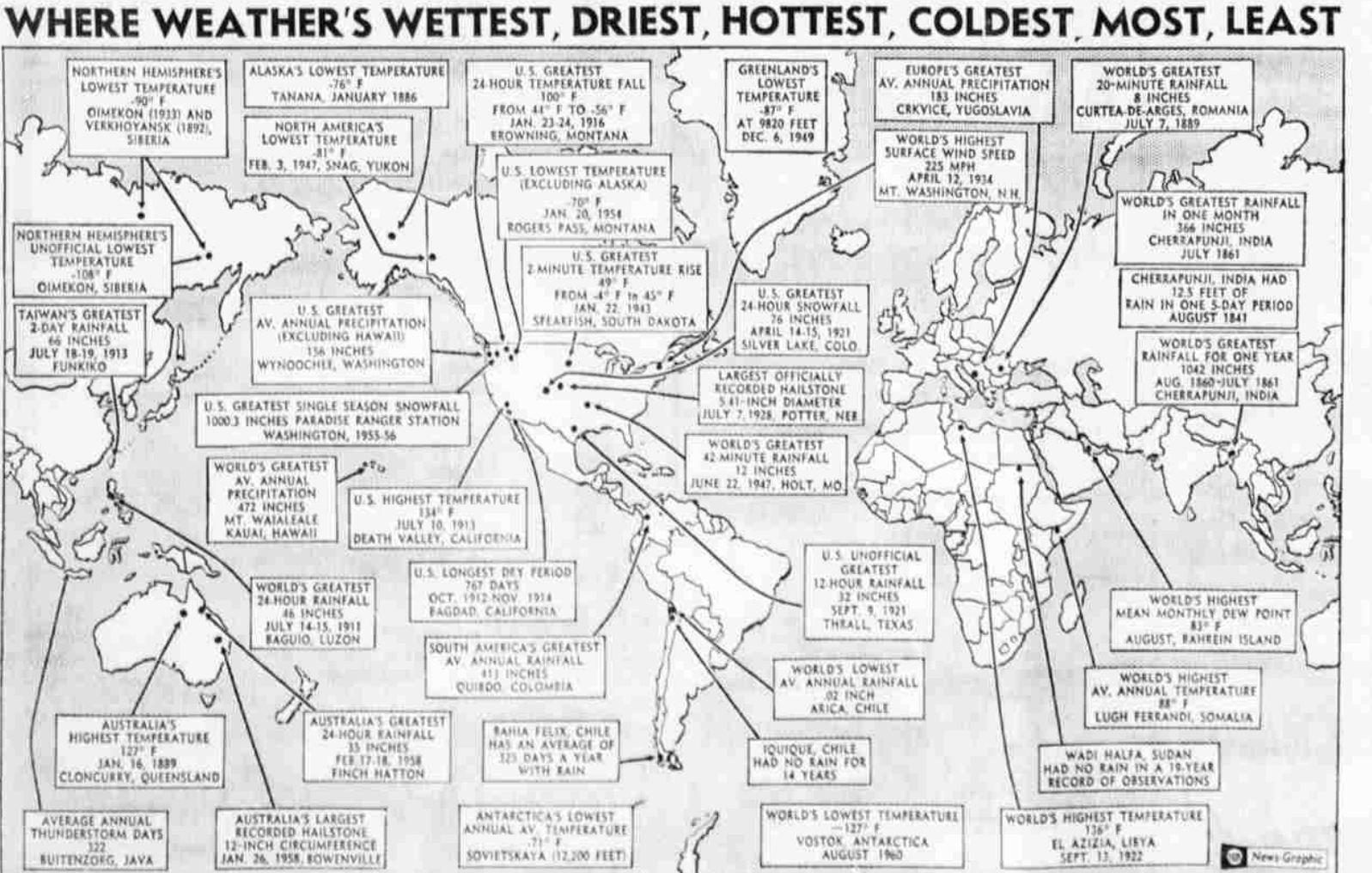
