College of Education with 5-4 presently and the best they could do if they win all their remaining games would be a tie of 12-4 providing the Owls lost their last three games.

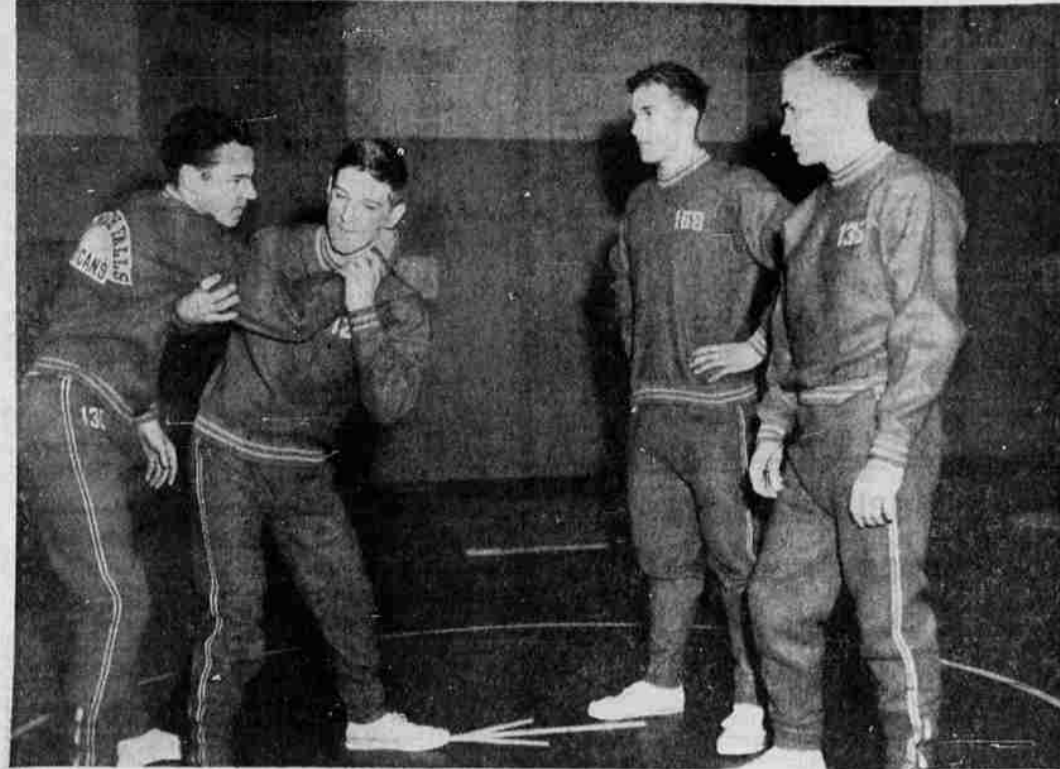
Three Tied For First In Phoenix Tourney
