

Boy Scouts Of Modoc Area Council Note 25th Anniversary This Week

A total of 1,600 cubs, scouts and explorers in the Klamath District, plus some 550 adult leaders, are celebrating two birthdays this week.

National scouting is now 83 years old and the Modoc Area Council has been in existence for 25 years. Prior to 1937 this area was part of Southern Oregon with headquarters in Medford.

The Klamath District is an administrative division of the Modoc Area Council and is comprised of Klamath County, except for that portion north of Chiloquin, and also of the Tulelake, Dorris area of Siskiyou County, Calif.

Another group of volunteers in the district functions through a group of leaders known as the District Committee. Membership of the committee consists of one man from each sponsoring organization called an institutional representative and certain members-at-large, who are recruited to serve in various capacities on six operating committees. These six operating groups of the District Committee are camping and activities, advancement, organization and extension, leadership training, finance, and health and safety.

The District Committee administers, plans and carries out the council program in its geographic area.

Red Cross Sets Goal For Tulelake District

TULELAKE—Edwin V. Lance, Lewis H. Blake, and Mrs. Irene Moore will head the 1963 Red Cross fund campaign in Tulelake, with a goal of \$1,863 to be collected in Tulelake and the surrounding area.

Gordon H. Hansen, chairman of the Tulelake Red Cross, announced that the campaign will open in February, with the target date for the goal to be reached by March 15.

Lance, chairman of the business division, is manager of the Tulelake Irrigation District and has been a worker in many Red Cross campaigns in the area. Lewis

H. Blake represents the State Farm Insurance in Tulelake and is an employee of the University of California Field Station; he will head up the rural section. Mrs. Moore, residential chairman, is in charge of the women's division and has been active in many community affairs.

Programs to be financed through the fund drive in the area include swimming instruction and transportation to the Malin pool each summer for children in the Newell and Tulelake area, and first aid instruction given to school bus drivers, operators of emergency vehicles, and

the general public in the area, in addition to the traditional Red Cross programs of assistance to disaster victims, aid to servicemen, and the volunteer blood donor program.
