

Lease Land Bids Opened

A total of 82 bids were received and opened Feb. 15 by the project office of the Bureau of Reclamation for the leasing of 11 units of public land in the League of Nations lease area of the Klamath Reclamation Project. These leases cover use of land in units averaging about 100 acres each, for agricultural and grazing purposes.

One of the highlights of the evening's program will be Franz Schubert's "Mass in G." This number will be accompanied by the string orchestra. Kathy Chilcote, soprano, Dennis Montague, baritone, and Rae Ann Davis, soprano, will be featured as soloists with the number. This great piece of choral literature was composed by Franz Schubert at the age of 18. He died at the early age of 31 with over 700 published works to his credit. This number was featured by the meeting of the Music Educators National Association held in Spokane, March 15-18, 1962.

This year's choir of 89 voices, has presented "The Messiah" as well as its own Christmas program during the holiday season. It has also appeared before the Rotary, Kiwanis and Lions clubs of Klamath Falls.

The 50-mile hike claimed its first pedestrian fatality Sunday. Other hikers footed chiropodist bills for treatment of tender feet.

Nevada's Gov. Grant Sawyer, Utah's Democratic National Committee woman Mrs. Lucy Redd, former major league baseball pitcher and entertainer Al Schacht, and a caravan of nearly 2,000 Pittsburgh hikers were among the tramping thousands Sunday.

Disks, jockies, newsmen, more Marines, doctors and legions of students also trudged about the countryside.

Two high school track stars from Sacramento, Calif., walked and ran 50.4 miles in 8 hours 27 minutes, the fastest time reported over the weekend.

In Honolulu 150 of 300 starters, including a 75-year-old woman and a ninth-month old baby in a carriage, covered the 50-mile distance.

Near Casper, Wyo., an auto struck and killed Willard Mitchell Jr., 34, as he was hiking to Glenrock, Wyo., with 18 others.

Mitchell's widow was in a hospital recovering from injuries suffered in an auto accident three weeks ago. The couple had four small children.

Governor Sawyer and five companions, including Mrs. Redd, completed a 25-mile hike over Nevada's Sage Flats Sunday night.
