

Try Serving Stuffed Spuds

Ever stuff baked potatoes with a combination of finely chopped onion, ground black pepper and sour cream? Or make quick sesame seed dinner rolls from a mix plus toasted sesame seeds?

BAKED POTATOES WITH ONION - SOUR CREAM DRESSING

Wash 6 baking potatoes and pat dry. Bake in a preheated hot oven (450 degrees) 1 hour or until done. To test for doneness: Press sides of potatoes with fingers wrapped in a towel. Cut off a slice from the end of each potato and scoop out centers. Being careful not to break the shells. Mash until fluffy. Add a little top milk and season to taste with salt, ground black pepper and butter or margarine. Pile into shells. Combine 1/2 cup sour cream with 3 tablespoons finely chopped onion and spoon over each potato. Garnish with paprika, if desired.

Note: If desired, sour cream and onion may be beaten into the mashed potatoes. In that case, place the stuffed potatoes under the broiler until tops are crusty and brown.

SESAME SEED PARTY ROLLS (2 dozen party-size rolls)

14 1/2 ounce package hot roll mix
1-3 cup toasted sesame seeds
1 egg white
Prepare hot roll mix according to directions on package, adding 1/4 cup toasted sesame seeds to dry mix. Let rise according to directions. Punch down and work dough on a lightly floured board, kneading about 1 minute. Pinch off pieces of dough and roll between palms to 3-inch lengths. Shape into bow-knots. Place on lightly greased cookie sheets. Beat egg white until foamy. Brush over top of rolls. Sprinkle with remaining sesame seeds. Let rise until doubled in size. Bake in a preheated hot oven (400 degrees) 15 minutes.

To toast sesame seeds: Place on an ungreased cookie sheet, in a preheated moderate oven (350 degrees) 20 to 22 minutes.

Canned Corn

Homestyle Corn Chowder will chase away winter chills. Cook sliced onion in butter or margarine until tender. If using plump whole kernel corn, drain and add the liquid to the onions. If using the cream-style corn, add just enough water to cover the onions. Bring liquid to a boil. Add two cups diced potatoes, cover and cook 10 minutes. Add two cups corn, three cups milk, one cup diced cooked ham and sprinkle with salt. Heat thoroughly. Garnish each serving with chopped parsley.

Corn Meat Loaf stays moist and tasty right down to the last delicious slice. Add canned corn to favorite meat loaf mixture and bake as usual.

Corn-Sausage Pudding is an intriguing treat. Beat two eggs, add two tablespoons flour and season with salt and pepper. Beat until smooth. Stir in two cups cream-style corn and 1/2 cup milk. Pour into a buttered nine-inch pie plate, a shallow four-cup baking dish or four one-cup custard cups. Bake 20 minutes at 350 degrees F. Remove from oven, arrange drained, canned sausages on top and bake until custard is set in the center, about 20 minutes. Serves four.

Cranie Corn adds a zesty flavor to wintertime meals. Cook a chopped onion in butter or margarine until tender and lightly browned. Add a one-pound can of tomatoes, sprinkle with sugar, salt and pepper. Simmer 10 minutes. Add a one-pound can of whole kernel corn and chopped green pepper. Simmer five minutes longer. Serves six.

"Chipped Beef à la Corn" boasts handsome canned corn kernels in the subtly spiced, creamed chipped beef mixture.

Corn Pancakes are a welcome variation for pancake mixes. For approximately 15 corn cakes: Combine one beaten egg, 1/2 cup milk, two tablespoons salad oil by melted shortening, one tablespoon sugar and a one-pound can of corn. Add one cup pancake mix, stirring only until flour is moistened.

Drop batter by tablespoons onto hot greased griddle and spread each cake with back of spoon. Cook until cakes are puffing, full of bubbles and the edges are cooked. Turn and cook the other side. Serve corn cakes with favorite topping—a sweet syrup and butter, bacon, sausage or ham, hot creamed chicken or meatballs in gravy.

DELICATESSEN SPECIAL

Make your own delicatessen style sandwiches at home. For an especially good one try this recipe: For each sandwich spread a slice of pumpernickel bread generously with mayonnaise. Arrange drained canned tongue on mayonnaise and top with lettuce leaf. Spread other slice of bread generously with blue cheese spread. Put cheese spread side down on lettuce and fasten sandwich with toothpick.

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
