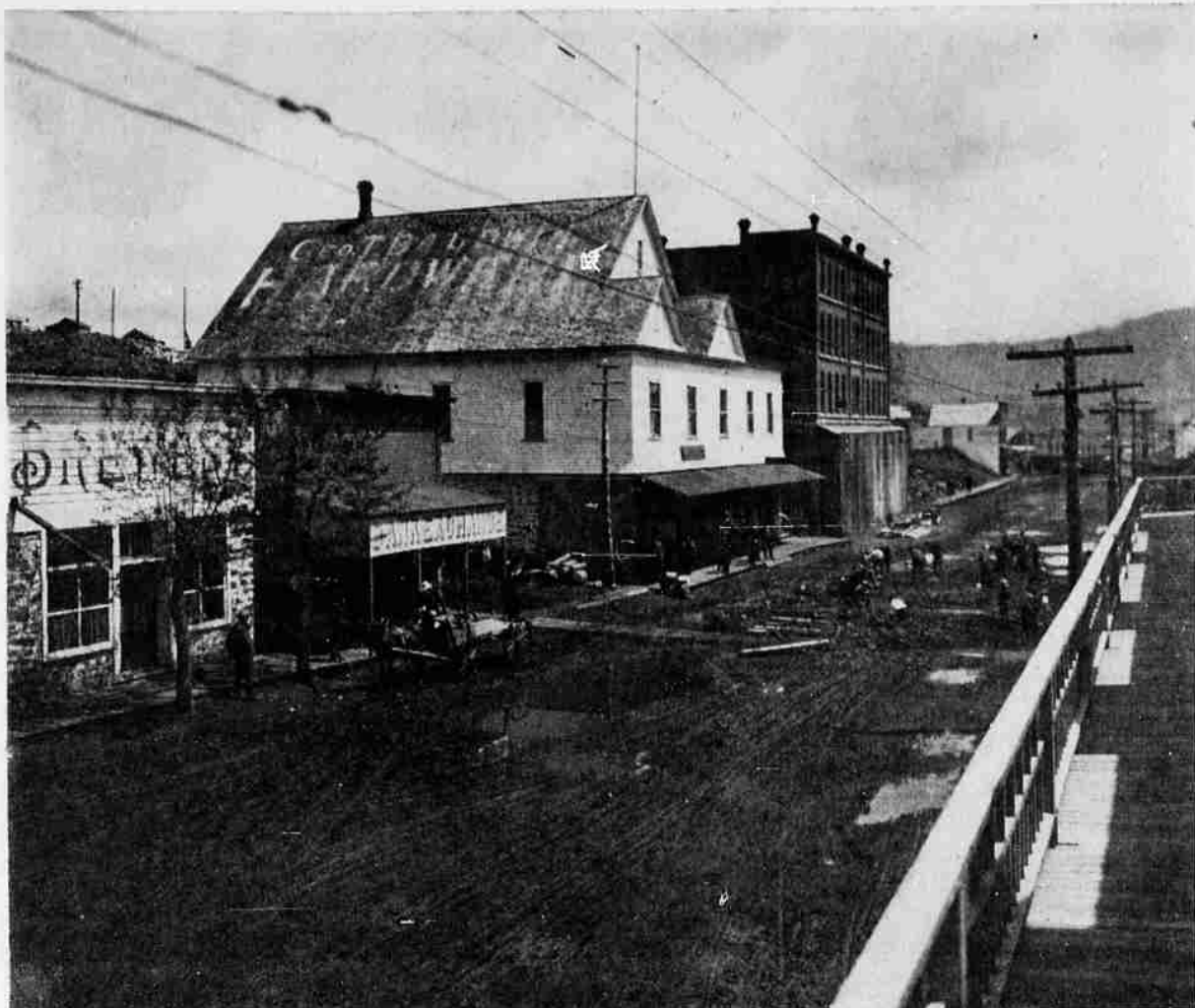




START OF LAYING TROLLEY RAILS — These two views were taken during the start of construction work on the Main Street section to prepare for the laying of the tracks for the horsecar line. The view at left was taken from the balcony of the Lakeside Inn (formerly known as the Linkville Hotel) and is looking east down Main Street.



Note that the front of the Baldwin Hardware Store (now Baldwin Hotel) has been boarded up. It was understood that dynamite had to be used in some spots to loosen the rock, although this fact has not been confirmed. In view at right, photographer on this day in 1906 moved up closer for a view taken from the wooden sidewalks which

lined the street. Reports of the incident state that work started about midnight on a Saturday and was rushed through Sunday and into Monday so that the roadbed would be ready on the Main Street section when the rails arrived. The pictures bear out this story since there are no rails stacked anywhere in the area.
