Electricians Quit Again
NEVADA TEST SITE (UPI) — Four hundred electricians, who only Monday ended a four-day wildcat walkout, today threw a picket line in a new dispute and turned back an estimated 2,000 workers.

The Atomic Energy Commission said that about 60 men were picketing the main gate of the site and that members of most crafts appeared to be honoring it or going inside only to pick up their tools.

It was the fifth strike here this year.

Union spokesmen said the walkout was in protest of Reynolds Electrical and Engineering Co., a prime AEC contractor, firing 66 radiation monitors who took part in last week's strike.

Reynolds said the monitors, members of the Electrician's Union, could not leave their jobs as they were important to the public health and safety.

Stagecoach Footwarmer Given To Local Museum

A footwarmer used in a stagecoach which operated between Lakeview and Klamath Falls during the frontier days and a tinted, panoramic photograph taken of Crater Lake in 1909 were two of five exhibits donated to the Klamath County Museum during February, curator Mrs. Lloyd Seeley announced Wednesday.

The photograph was one of two taken of the lake for the White Pelican Hotel early this century and came into the possession of the donor, Mrs. David Goehring, 1975 Manzanita, sometime after the hotel burned down during the 1920s.

The footwarmer, which contained a hot brick when in use, was one of a type furnished to each passenger of the stage line as the coach ran its schedule during the winter months. The item was donated by Ed Gowen, 1855 Portland Street, a past county commissioner and early stage driver, Mrs. Seeley said.

Three other exhibits included a cradle of the Hoopa Indians, a tribe of Northern California; two hand guns manufactured about 1900; and what is believed to be a tooth from an Oredont, a pig-like animal which roved the Klamath Basin in herds about 35 million years ago.

The fossil was donated by Mrs. Glenn Shannon, 6047 Shasta Way, who discovered it on the top of the ground near Tule Lake while she was on a hunting trip with her husband. The tooth will be sent to the University of Oregon to be positively identified.

The Hoopa cradle was contributed by James H. Land, 1903 Crest Street, who said the Indian item has never been used. He explained that his father-in-law commissioned some Hoopa Indians to make the cradle. But the Indians took so long to finish the job that the person for whom the cradle was intended outgrew it before it was finished.

The hand guns were donated by Harold E. White, a gun collector of 703B Wright Avenue.

Also on display this month is the second volume of colored photographs depicting birds of Klamath County. Another picture exhibit is in the historical section and shows the progress of Klamath Falls from its beginnings to 1910.

State Master Wheeler, in his address, complimented the Valley Falls Grange on its exhibit of ritualistic work and hospitality.

"Such meetings," he said, "tend to bring granges into closer relationship with the head office."

Wheeler also urged subordinate grange masters to attend the state grange meeting at Oregon City and all grange members to attend the National Grange meeting, to be held in Portland Nov. 2.

Lecturer Dorothy Sims read the Valley Falls Grange history and recognized 12 charter members present at the meeting. It was announced by Eastside Grange Lecturer Velma Newcombe that the degree team would put on the first and second degrees for ever, one who had not received them at the Thomas Creek Grange Hall at 8 p.m. March 30.

Following the meeting, a round of square dancing was featured and a midnight lunch was served.

Stamp Measures Said Distorted

SALEM (UPI) — Rep. Eugene Hulett, D-Eugene, denied today his trading stamp bill would do away with the stamps in Oregon.

Hulett accused the Sperry and Hutchinson trading stamp firm of trying to distort the effects of the bill.

Hulett's bill would require firms to make their stamps available to any merchant, and would levy a county license fee on stamp companies.

Hulett said the bill would provide several million dollars in income at the county level and would be a "regulatory act to protect the consuming public."
