Silver Candlesticks Prettier With Proper Length Candles

Handsome silver candlesticks are the pride and joy of any homemaker because they lend such elegant beauty to the home, but by following a few general rules about the candles you use, it is possible to enjoy even more beautiful centerpieces and other decorative effects with them.

Here are three simple rules concerning the proportionate lengths of candles to the candlesticks used. Low candle holders, those under seven inches in height, look their best with candles 18 to 24 inches in length. Medium holders from 7 to 10 inches high show up to the best advantage when holding candles from 10 to 16 inches high. And tall ones of 12 inches or more are best adapted to candles 10 to 12 inches long.

Silver candlesticks filled with lighted candles can lend an exciting air to the simplest of little parties or dinners. It is fun to dramatize a table arrangement by matching candles to the color of flowers in the centerpiece — especially when you use the dark-

er more unusual tones which are available now.

Still another interesting idea is to use only candlelight in the living room. Fill several silver holders with candles the same tone as the gown you are wearing and place them strategically about the room so that no matter where you move, you are in a flattering light near a candle which matches your gown.

Curtain Washing

Glazed chintz curtains will retain their shiny surface longer if washed in cold water and light-duty liquid detergent.

Fiberglass curtains should not be machine washed. For convenience they may be placed in a tub or washer for a 10-15 minute soaking in warm water and all-purpose detergent. Don't spin, wring or agitate mechanically. If heavily soiled, drain water and repeat the soaking with clean water and detergent. Then rinse without mechanical agitation. Remove curtains from washer, shake out excess water and rehang. Fiberglass should not be put in the dryer.

Unlike the man-made fibers, cotton curtains absorb soil and require different laundering treatment. Use hot water and all-purpose detergent for white cotton curtains. For colored fabrics, choose a light-duty detergent and warm water. Agitate 10 minutes, dryer.
