

Vatican Newspaper Denounces Boxing

VATICAN CITY, (UPI) — The Vatican newspaper denounced boxing Saturday night as "a crime," "murder" and a form of "practical atheism" which takes human lives for the sake of fun and money.

The scathing editorial in Osservatore Romano commented on the critical injuries Davey Moore suffered in Thursday's Los Angeles fight which cost him the world featherweight title.

Reliterating past Vatican denunciations of boxing, it called the sport "substantially illicit" and implicitly asked governments to outlaw it.

They call them featherweights, "but the feathers are sledgehammers, murderous sledgehammers," Osservatore said.

"Here is another crime committed in the name of the boxing idol. Another moral taint on our civilized usages which do not agree to dutiful prohibitions and prefer to serve the childish myths of certain largely instinctive and often unconsciously savage crowds."

Disregard for human life in boxing is no less materialistic or atheistic than the teachings of Osservatore said.

"The civilization of our world must consider that materialism

does not hide out only behind the structures or the proclamations of militant atheists," the editorial said.

Actor Felled By Hepatitis

HOLLYWOOD (UPI) — Actor Burt Lancaster remained in bed today on his doctor's orders because of a "mild" case of infectious hepatitis.

Lancaster, who has been nominated for an academy award for his picture, "The Birdman of Alcatraz," will be required to stay in bed at his home for from two weeks to a month, Dr. Syman Engleberg said.

Vatican experts said that although the editorial did not necessarily reflect the official view of the church, it certainly represented a widespread Catholic school of thought. The church as such has never officially asked for the outlawing of boxing, but a growing number of Catholic theologians have described it as inhuman and morally illicit.

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Mexican Narcotics Raid Nets Eighteen

TIJUANA, Mexico (UPI) — Eighteen persons including three Southern Californians were held in City Jail Saturday on narcotics charges after a raid on a local residence.

Jailed on charges of possession of narcotics were: Kay Wyndor, 26, a photographer's model, and Mrs. Marjorie Blodgett, 30, both of Pacoima, and Jesse Mathis, 42, Chula Vista. The other 15, all Mexican citizens, were held on similar charges.

Federal agents said they found a handful of marijuana in Miss Wyndor's purse and she admitted buying it in Downey, Calif.

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
