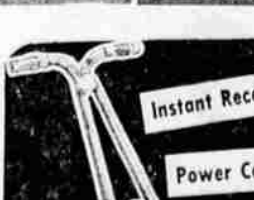

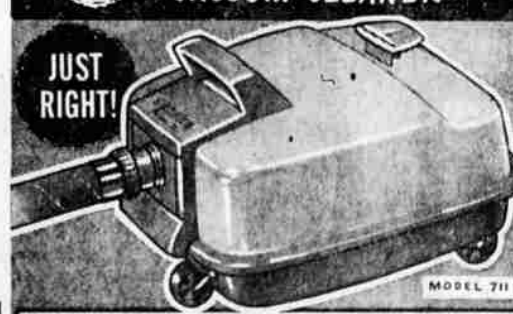

Dr. Romney Takes Post

EUGENE—Chancellor Roy E. Lieutallen has announced the appointment of Dr. Miles C. Romney as vice chancellor for Academic Affairs for the Oregon State System of Higher Education.

Dr. Romney has been a member of the staff of the school of education of the University of Oregon since 1932. For the past several months he has been on leave from his position as associate dean to serve on the chancellor's staff as executive director of the higher education coordinating council for graduate study.

As vice chancellor he will continue as executive director for the coordinating council and will be responsible for interinstitutional curricular planning. He will work closely with the curriculum committee of the board of higher education. Dr. Francis Nickerson, assistant to the chancellor for curricular affairs, will assist Dr. Romney in his new role.

Dr. Romney graduated from Utah State University in 1935 and received his Ph.D. degree in educational administration from Columbia University in 1947. He has served on the staffs of Utah State, the University of Michigan and Wayne University.
