Plans Talked For Alcatraz

WASHINGTON (UPI)—A House judiciary subcommittee today heard a request that a five-man federal commission be set up to decide what to do with Alcatraz Island.

The committee heard testimony in support of a bill by Rep. John F. Shelley, D-Calif., to establish the commission to study wide-ranging recommendations for future use of the site of the abandoned federal prison in San Francisco Bay.

A spokesman for the committee said "technical details" of the legislation still had to be worked out and that action on the bill probably would not come until next week.

Committee members learned that suggestions for future uses of Alcatraz ranged from turning "The Rock" into a refuge for seagulls to keeping it as a museum, complete with waxwork figures of some of the prison's more notorious inmates.

Shelley, who has announced that he will run for mayor of San Francisco, recommended that a statue of St. Francis or one symbolizing East-West friendship be erected on the island.

Frat 'Joke' Backfires

SALEM (UPI) — They were kiddin' at the University of Oregon, but the joke backfired in the Senate during ceremonies honoring Oregon State athlete Terry Baker Tuesday.

The Oregon Daily Emerald's April Fool edition carried the headline "All UO Frats To Be Closed."

Sen. Walter Pearson, D-Portland, apparently didn't think it was very funny. He charged the newspaper had taken advantage of the traditional April 1 edition to ridicule legislators.

He said in apparently angry tones, regarding the closing of fraternities: "I know that this is their aim."

He termed the issue of the Emerald an example of the type of pressure being put on the legislature by the State Board of Higher Education.

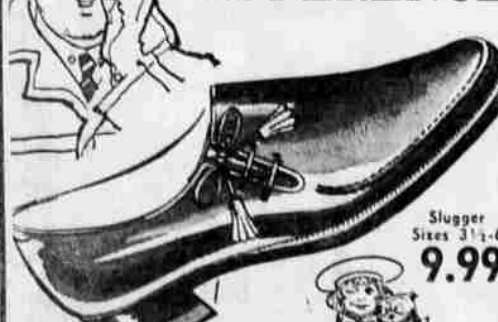
"I think we should make it known that we don't want the fraternities closed," Pearson said.
