

Songs And Sermons Proclaim 'Christ Is Risen'

Today Christians all over the world are observing Good Friday in commemoration of the crucifixion of Christ, and on Sunday they will observe His triumphant resurrection.

More than 1900 years ago Christ declared that He was the Son of God and was subsequently arrested, tried, and found guilty of blasphemy. With the swift tide of events, He was taken to the hill of Calvary on Friday and nailed through the feet and hands to a crude wooden cross.

When He was dead, His body was placed in a tomb by friends who bound it with linen cloths and spices in the manner of burial in that day. It lay there over Saturday, the Jewish Sabbath.

Early Sunday morning, the third morning after the events attending His crucifixion, it was discovered that the tomb was empty. Christ had risen from the dead, fulfilling the Scriptures.

The theme of Easter will be proclaimed this Sunday in churches throughout the Klamath Basin. "Christ Is Risen."

FIRST CHRISTIAN

The congregations of the First Christian Church and the Suburban Christian Church will herald in Easter with a joint sunrise service at 6 a.m. in the Suburban Christian sanctuary, to be followed by an Easter breakfast at 7 a.m. Rev. Robert L. John, First Christian minister, will bring the message entitled "The Right Side of Easter."

First Christian Church will also have Easter Sunday worship services at 8:30 and 11 a.m. Special music will include a solo by Jerry Ruth Wickersham and a number by the Worship Choir, "All Hail Victorious King." The sermon topic will be "God's Good Morning."

Rev. John has announced that a program of Easter music, featuring solos, duets, ensembles, and selections by the choir, will be presented at 7:30 p.m. Sunday evening. The program will be under the direction of Mrs. Roberta Harlan.

ST. PAUL'S EPISCOPAL

St. Paul's Episcopal Church will observe Easter Sunday with the choral Holy Eucharist and sermon at 7 and 11:15 a.m. Rev. Robert L. Greene has selected for the title of his Easter message, "Before and After."

Accompanied at the organ by Linda Harville, the Senior Choir will present "Communion Service" by William, "Christ, O Life Passover" by Schilling, and "In Joseph's Lovely Garden" by Dickinson at both services.

The 9:15 a.m. Holy Eucharist for the family will feature choral selections by the Junior Choir. Under the direction of Mrs. George Nicholson, the choir will sing "Communion Service" by Cruickshank and "Praise the Lord."

On Easter Sunday Mass will be said at 6, 7, 8, 9:30 (High Mass) and 11 a.m. and at 12:15 and 7:30 p.m. The Masses will be conducted by Msgr. T. P. Casey, Rev. Austin Cribbin, and Rev. Charles Grant.

FIRST PRESBYTERIAN

Services at 9 and 11 a.m., conducted by Rev. Robert C. Groves will mark the Easter Sunday observances at the First Presbyterian Church. His sermon topic will be "A New Dimension to Destiny."
