Fill Land Bill Gets Easy Okay

SALEM (UPI)—A bill to let upland owners get title to offshore river or harbor "fill" lands breezed through the Oregon House 54-5 today and went to the Senate.
It was necessitated by an attorney general's opinion last year that shed doubt on the right of the state land board to dispose of such lands.
The bill applies to "fill" lands built on submerged lands in navigable rivers, harbors, inlets, or lakes.
Areas it will apply to range from Coos Bay to Tongue Point at Astoria and Arlington on the Columbia River.
Under the bill, public owners, such as cities or ports, would get title to adjacent "fill" lands.

Shasta Hospital Plans Two Additions

MOUNT SHASTA — William E. Smith, administrator of Mount Shasta Community Hospital, announced plans last week for the construction of two ultra-modern additions to the hospital. The construction, more than doubling the size of the hospital, will start as soon as the weather permits.
An obstetrics wing and surgery wing are the first additions to be made and should be completed by next fall. Further plans call for construction of a new wing of semi-private rooms which will provide beds for 40 patients. At present it is a 23 bed hospital. The new rooms have been designed with all outside walls, ceiling to floor, with thermopane glass and a landscaped pavilion for visiting and sunning.
There will be television installed in one end of the solarium.
Smith said one goal, by the time the additions are made, is to be able to care for local chronically ill patients under medical aid to the aged program instead of having them moved elsewhere. He also stated there are 21 doctors, including specialists, now using the hospital.
The surgery and obstetrics wings will be added where the ambulance entrance is now located. There will be several rooms for personnel, supplies, and equipment. A new operating room is in the plans, with a new delivery room opposite two of the obstetrics rooms.
A new nursery will have complete television monitoring, both audio and visual, and super sensitive microphones detecting the slightest sound. Under the wing of semi-private rooms on the downstairs floor, new facilities will be provided for offices, supply rooms, x-ray, laboratory, and emergency rooms.
The entire project should reach completion by the fall of 1964. Architects are Wesley J. Barnum and Malcolm Mau of Sacramento.
