Freak Hand Wins Tilt

No par contest would be complete without one freak hand and Bill Root and Barry Rossler concocted a humdinger when they prepared the hands for the Association of American Playing Card Manufacturers' Intercollegiate Tournament.

South has a really big hand and should be amazed to find his partner able to make a positive response to his opening two bid. He seems to be cold for 13 tricks if his partner can show the missing ace. South uses Blackwood whereupon North bids five diamonds to show that one ace.

South can now get a bidding par for either seven clubs or seven no-trump and then finds that in order to get points for playing the hand he must play spade lead.

Par contest or no par contest South can count all the tricks he needs and then some unless all four diamonds are held in one hand against him and should try to find a play to guard against this.

The play is to win the first trick with dummy's ace of spades, then discard his ace of hearts on dummy's queen of spades.

This establishes three heart tricks in dummy and South now throws his ace, king and queen of clubs on them.

Then he leads dummy's jack of clubs and when the ten spot drops the rest of dummy's club suit is good and South makes the hand in spite of bad break in diamonds.

A—Pass! There may be a better spot, but your partner has shown very good clubs and he is more likely to hold five clubs than five hearts. Do not go to seven because your hand is too weak in playing strength although you do have plenty of high cards.

Assassination Plot Broken

PARIS (UPI) — A new plot to assassinate President Charles de Gaulle may have been smashed with the arrest in a gun battle of a leading Secret Army Organization terrorist already under sentence of death for an August, 1962, assassination attempt, police sources said Friday.

Two policemen patrolling the area around the historic Pantheon on the Paris Left Bank Thursday night shot and killed one Secret Army Organization terrorist and wounded and captured a second when they found the two men trying to steal a car similar to that used by the president.

Friday morning police identified the wounded man as Serge Bernier, alias Jean Murat, sentenced to death in absentia last month

for his part in the attempt to machine-gun De Gaulle at suburban Petit-Clamart last Aug. 22. Bernier was "transport officer" of the secret army's "Mission three" in metropolitan France. It was he who provided the three vehicles from which the OAS men launched their attack on De Gaulle last year, police said.

Police sources said they were working on the theory that Bernier and his OAS colleague were stealing a car as part of a new plot against De Gaulle when they were surprised by police.

The shooting occurred in a quiet side street behind the Pantheon, tomb of many of France's illustrious citizens which now is surrounded by a maze of night spots and student haunts.

Patrolmen Jean Arcelin and Claude Moirizot were patrolling the area because of recent complaints of automobile thefts when they found the two men attempting to open the rear door of a locked Citroen car.

As they approached one of the men, Marceteau de Brem pulled a gun and shot Arcelin, gravely wounding him.

Bernier ran but was wounded by one of the bullets fired by Moirizot. Both men had false identity papers. But police later established the identity of De Brem as a well-known secret army terrorist who, they said, sheltered Bernier and another plotter after the attempt to kill De Gaulle failed last August.

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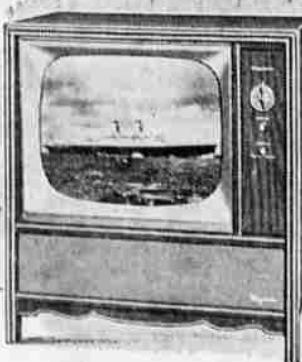
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Explanations Given For Last Week's Coinword Puzzle

Woman Draws

4-Year Term

PORTLAND (UPI)—Star Elaine Wallace, convicted of manslaughter in the stabbing of her husband, drew a four-year probationary term and a suspended \$2,000 fine from Circuit Judge Richard J. Burke Thursday.

The 32-year-old woman was charged with killing her husband, Jack, after a family quarrel.

Her attorney said Mrs. Wallace will live with her mother in Salem and may turn to work with retarded children.

Authorities continued to investigate telephoned threats to two jurors during the trial. The caller threatened to "cut up" the jurors unless they acquitted the woman.

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JETS TO FRANCE

WASHINGTON (UPI)—The United States plans to stick by its agreement to sell France 12 jet aircraft tankers which can be used to refuel long-range bombers expected to be part of France's planned nuclear striking force.

The State Department said Thursday "We are going ahead with our commitment" to sell France the KC133 tankers.

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
