Early Opposition To Constitution Revision Stemmed From State Bar

Editors note: The House is scheduled to give its verdict Monday on a proposed new constitution to replace the present 106-year-old one.

SALEM (UPI)—When the Commission on Constitutional Revision completed its draft of a proposed new state constitution last year, the earliest and strongest opposition came from the State Bar.

Some of the sharpest changes suggested occurred in the article dealing with the judicial branch. The bar objected to many of the changes. The document was presented to the legislature when it convened in January.

For three and one half months, the House and Senate Committees on Constitutional Revision have worked it over. Both the commission and the committees agree that a new constitution must be a liaison between Oregon's first century and her next, a blend of the past and the future.

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Hoffa Defends Strike

WASHINGTON (UPI)—Teamster President James R. Hoffa said today there could never be such a thing as a "national emergency" in peacetime that would justify government action to end a strike.

Hoffa told a congressional committee the only time the government would have the right to take any such action would be in wartime.

The controversial union leader said a strike might affect the national economy but there is no reason why it would have to touch off a national emergency.

Hoffa testified before the House Merchant Marine Committee. Its chairman, Rep. Herbert C. Bon-

ner, D-N.C., has introduced legislation that would require compulsory arbitration in the maritime industry when other means to settle disputes have failed.

Bonner proposed a bill as a result of the East and Gulf Coast dock strike late last year.

"You cannot force people to work, no matter how much power you have," Hoffa said. "You cannot contain the spirit of people by writing laws."

Hoffa told the congressmen that a strike "wasn't the worst thing in the world." He also argued that management does not have to shut down the whole industry when one company is hit by a strike.

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
