Wins Upped By Success

Kenneth G. McIntyre of Staten Island is one of my regular correspondents. Ken seems to have more than his share of troubles at the bridge table and most of his letters concern tragedies.

Ken writes, "I don't suppose you approve of my partner's heart response, his pass to one spade, or his double of two hearts, but we wound up with a top score."

I don't approve of the one heart response. East should respond one diamond since there is no future for his side in hearts unless West can bid the suit. Then East might have tried one no-trump instead of a pass. Finally his double of two hearts might have proved suicidal. After all, South can make three hearts against any defense, but now see what happened to South.

Ken opened the ace and any other club. He hoped East would be able to trump the second lead of the suit.

South was in dummy and tried the heart finesse. Ken made his singleton king and led a third club which East was able to ruff.

Now East led a trump and careful defense held South to five trumps and a diamond plus the one club he had already made.

Proving that nothing succeeds like success, and that sometimes bridge is about as uneventful as sitting in a rocking chair on the edge of a precipice.

**High Court
Backs Judge**

SALEM (UPI)—The Oregon Supreme Court ruled Wednesday that a log trucker injured while unloading logs must seek remedy under the workman's compensation act, not outside it.

The high court said trucker Jimmie A. Childers, lacked grounds for bringing independent action against the Schaefer Lumber Co.

The decision affirmed Judge Edward Leary in an appeal from Lane County.

Childers was hit while unloading logs at the company's log pond. He had been assisted in the operation by employees of the company.

Childers contended he was engaged in a pick up and delivery operation that would give him grounds for bringing third party action.

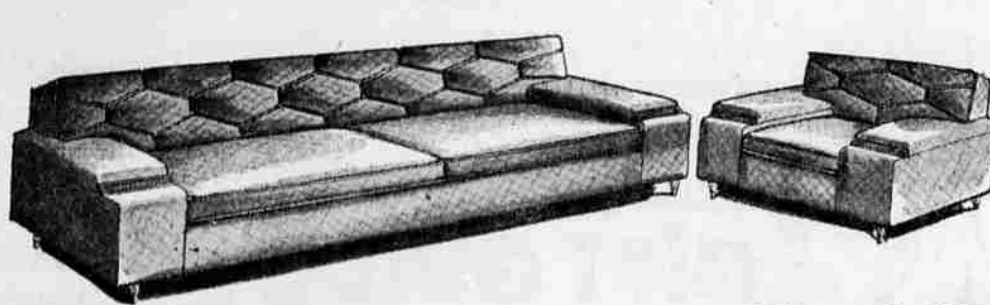
The Supreme Court agreed with the trial court that both parties were engaged in a common enterprise requiring joint efforts. It said the ordinary meaning of pick up and delivery cannot be extended to operations such as loading or unloading logs.

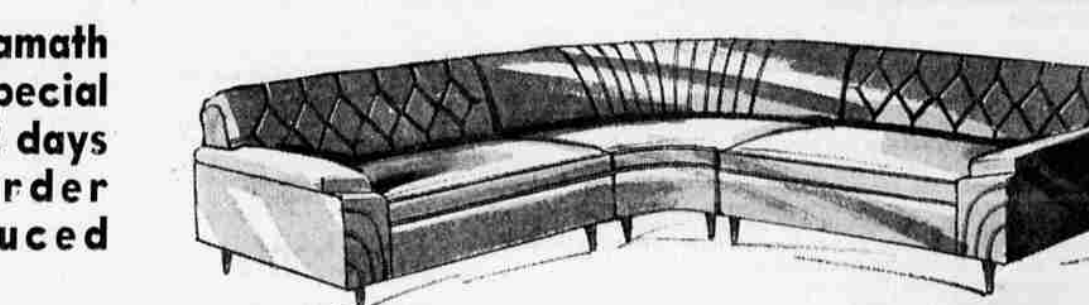

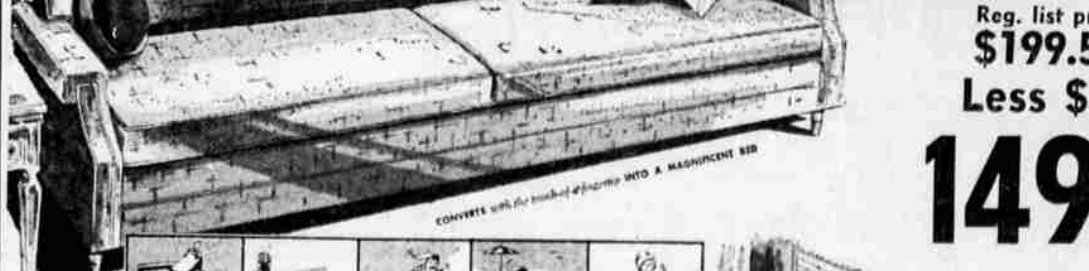

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Space Duo Plans Fall In Arrears

WASHINGTON (UPI)—The boss of this country's manned space program said today the Gemini Project for putting two men into orbit together has fallen behind by six months or so.

But the official, Brigadier General James G. Fulton, R-Pa., said his calculations show that the United States already is 18 months behind Russia in the effort to put a man on the moon.

Fulton said that this was the first time he had heard anybody say that we were ahead in the moon race.

"I don't say that," Fulton said. "I say that if all they are doing is what they have shown—which I doubt—we're far ahead. But I have no knowledge about what they are doing underground."

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
