AOI Member List Requested

SALEM (UPI) — The House Labor and Industries Committee voted 5-4 Tuesday to ask for a list of members of Associated Oregon Industries.

The action came at a hearing on the Senate-passed workmen's compensation bill, termed a modified "three-way" bill.

AOI has supported most features of the bill. Labor also has supported parts of it.

The list of AOI members was requested from Henry E. Baldridge of Portland, Rep. Richard Kennedy, D-Eugene.

Baldridge was reluctant. Kennedy replied, "does this indicate you are unwilling to furnish the committee with a list."

Baldridge said the association will take the request under consideration.

On The Record Production Cut On Wet Lands

CORVALLIS (UPI) — Rains have soaked western Oregon farm and orchard lands beyond the point where full production can be expected this year, according to Oregon State University agricultural specialists.

Heavy rains, following a cold, wet April, are forcing drastic shifts in crop production plans for the season in the Willamette Valley.

Specialists said soggy weather also has raised the threat of rust disease spreading in bluegrass fields. Disease and insect problems have also been heightened in horticultural crops, since orchards have been too wet to permit use of spray equipment.

Crash Victim Near Recovery

NEW YORK (UPI) — Helen Klien, the 21-year-old Brooklyn girl who was stranded recently in the frozen Canadian Northwest for 48 days, was released Friday from Columbia Presbyterian Medical Center.

The girl wore a bandage and slipped on her right foot. Due to frostbite and gangrene, the toes of that foot had been surgically removed. But she said, "I feel fine. I'm sure glad to be going home."

Mrs. Klien, a government worker in Alaska, had accepted a plane ride home with Ralph Flores, 42, San Bruno, Calif. The plane was forced down Feb. 4 in the Yukon. She and the pilot survived on melted snow.
