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Welfare Budget Approved

SALEM (UPI) — The full Ways and Means Committee Tuesday approved a \$106.7 million welfare budget.

The budget was cut \$21,000 from the amount asked by Gov. Mark Hatfield. The budget includes funds for an additional 128 caseworkers, 37 of whom will make a special effort to help recipients get off the welfare rolls.

Also included is a special seven-man team to make a continuing study to root out fraud cases.

The state's share will be about \$41.9 million, the federal government will supply \$49.8 million, and the counties \$13.8 million.

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
