4 Mountain Passes Open

Four mountain passes will open this week, with one opening Wednesday and three on Thursday, according to Forrest Cooper, state highway engineer.

The Mt. Hood Loop, Oregon 35, was opened to traffic at 10 a.m. Wednesday, May 22. The route was cleared from south of Parkdale to the junction of U.S. 26 just east of Government Camp.

The other highways were opened to traffic at 8 a.m. Thursday, May 23. These are the McKenzie Pass, Oregon 242; East and West Diamond Lake Highways and Crater Lake North, Oregon 230. Signs and barriers will be taken down the afternoon before opening.

These routes are closed each winter by the Highway Department when light traffic and heavy snowfall make it impractical to carry on snow removal operations. Alternate, all-weather routes serve the areas during the closures.

Construction projects will be in progress on three of the highways. On the Mt. Hood Highway there will be a Bureau of Public Roads construction project in the vicinity of Polalde Creek. The Bureau of Public Roads also will have construction projects on East Diamond Lake and the Crater Lake North highways.

Callison, manager of the chamber, related the contents of two letters received at the chamber since last week. The first correspondence was from C. D. Lawrence, manager of the Klamath Project for the Bureau of Reclamation, in which he acknowledged the receipt of a letter from the chamber that urged the bureau to continue its study of the proposed development of the Lost River watershed.

Lawrence wrote that several problems were blocking resumption of the study and as a result it will be some time "before we can proceed with it."

He said the bureau would consider the chamber's views on the matter as developments occur affecting the planning program.

The other letter was from the Portland Junior Chamber of Commerce requesting a \$30 donation from the local chamber to defray costs for a publicity program publicizing Oregon. Callison indicated that similar letters had been sent to other chambers throughout the state.

He requested Bob Crittenden, president of the local junior chamber and guest at Wednesday's meeting, to investigate and learn exactly for what purpose the money would be spent.

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
