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DROP VIDEO PROJECT

WASHINGTON UPI—The U.S. foreign aid agency has quietly dropped a project to bring educational television to underdeveloped countries.

The project, part of an abandoned \$1.6 million program, would have put more than 1,000 large transistorized television sets in remote areas of Africa and elsewhere. The idea came under fire in Congress last year.

Investigators discovered that an official of the Agency for International Development (AID) negotiated a contract for the sets without giving major television manufacturers a fair chance to bid.
