

# Giants Rout Koufax In First Frame; Orioles Rip Indians

## League Champions Led By Cepeda

Let Alvin Dark sprinkle a little salt on all those criticisms of Orlando Cepeda and they won't taste half bad.

In fact, they may taste almost as sweet as the San Francisco Giants' Friday night 7-1 victory over the Los Angeles Dodgers that enabled Dark's team to take a two-game lead in the National League race.

And, in case Dark needs some pepper to go with the salty words, let him mark down in that little black book in which he judges his players that "Orlando the unwanted" merely put the blitz to no-hit ace Sandy Koufax and provided the big blow that snapped the Dodgers' eight-game winning streak.

Friday night Cepeda hit a shot into right center field for a three-run double that put Koufax on the ropes and was the big blow of the Giants' first-inning five-run rally. Felipe Alou followed with a two-run homer and then Juan Marichal did the rest with a sparkling four-hitter that gave the Giants their first victory of the year over the Dodgers.

Koufax, who pitched a no-hitter against the Giants the last time he faced them, suffered his second loss against six wins. It was Marichal's sixth victory of the campaign and gave him a 7-5 lifetime mark against the arch-rival Dodgers. He lost his bid for a shutout in the sixth inning as pinch-hitter Don Zimmer homered.

They were the first of three separate meets held Saturday on Modoc by the KBAA, their first endeavor at sponsoring such a meet. It was the biggest meet to be staged ever on Modoc with over 350 contestants. The eighth and ninth graders ran in the afternoon portion and the high school and open meets at night.

There were some good times in the events by the young track aspirants. There were several double winners, led by Scott Smelcer in the dashes. Smelcer won the 75-yard dash and the 150-yard dash in 8.45 and 16.6 respectively.

All first places set Saturday are records and will be there for others to shoot at and break. They are records because this is the first of many such meets planned in the summer by the KBAA.

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## Robinson Powers Birds' Victory

It's an old baseball joke that the third baseman should pay his own way into the ballpark but the Baltimore Orioles would gladly pass the hat for Brooks Robinson if he were ever stopped at the gate.

As far as the Orioles are concerned, the 26-year-old Robinson is the best third baseman in the American League—and getting better all the time. He went over the 300-mark for the first time in his career in 1962 and this season he's belting away at a .312 clip.

With Robinson playing a major role, the Orioles have won five straight games and 10 of their last 11 to move into a 1½-game lead in the AL.

Robinson hit a two-run homer and a pair of singles in three trips to the plate Friday night to lead the Orioles to a 7-4 victory over the Cleveland Indians and give ex-Giant Mike McCormick his first AL triumph. Russ Snyder also weighed in with a two-run homer as the Orioles tagged Sam McDowell with his fourth loss against two wins.

The Minnesota Twins beat the Chicago White Sox, 6-6, the New York Yankees defeated the Washington Senators, 5-3, the Boston Red Sox downed the Detroit Tigers, 5-2, and the Kansas City Athletics beat the Los Angeles Angels, 3-1, in other AL action.

In the National League, the San Francisco Giants downed the Los Angeles Dodgers, 7-1, the St. Louis Cardinals routed the New York Mets, 10-4, the Pittsburgh Pirates whipped the Milwaukee Braves, 7-2, the Philadelphia Phillies topped the Cincinnati Reds, 3-1, and the Houston Colts edged the Chicago Cubs, 6-5, in 12 innings.

Joe Pepitone's three-run home run in the sixth inning enabled the Yankees to move into second place and tagged manager Gil

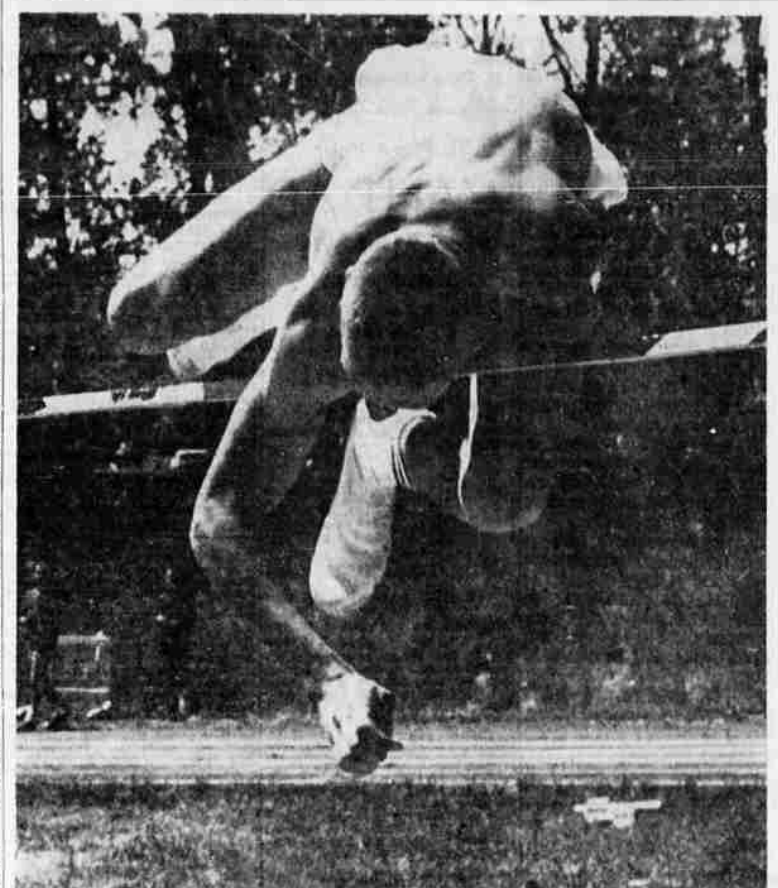
Hodges with his second straight loss since taking over the Senators. Whitey Ford struck out seven and pitched a six-hitter to win his fifth game while Dave Stenhouse suffered his fifth setback.  
Bill Monbouquette struck out 12 batters and pitched a six-hitter to win his fifth game for the Red Sox. Chuck Schilling's two-run single and a homer by Frank Malzone were the big blows for the Red Sox, who tagged Hank Aguirre with his fourth loss. A total of 13 Red Sox struck out as the teams set an AL record and tied the major league mark of 25 strikeouts by both clubs in a nine-inning game.  
Wayne Causey had three singles in five trips to raise his AL-leading average to .368 and stretch his hitting streak to 10 games for the Athletics. Dave Wickersham and Johnny Wyatt combined in a seven-hitter. Rookie Hector Martinez also contributed a homer to the Kansas City attack.
