

Shasta Sewer Hookup Plans Made

MOUNT SHASTA—Every home owner in South Mount Shasta will be able to hook on to the sewer line within the next week as the construction which has been going on for several months is now completed, said Charles Echols, city engineer.

A resolution adopting and submitting a budget for expenditure funds, for maintaining and constructing signal lights was adopted.

Councilman Howard Priddy and Herman Barr were appointed to contact the Richfield Oil Company in answer to a letter from them regarding the construction of a station on the present city hall site.

The Bear Claws, a parents booster club, will have concessions from J. Castle Street at the July 4 celebration and also participate in the queen contest and parade. Concessions will be open July 3 to 7:30 p.m. and July 4 to 10 p.m.

The council went on record as opposing Senate Bill No. 1491 which calls for a tax on motel and hotel trade.

Other business matters concerned Mount Airport. The Siskiyou County board of supervisors anticipate June 30 as the date for giving the deed to the cities of Mount Shasta and Dunsmuir jointly. Council received a legal description and map from the supervisors.

The lease agreement with Shasta Alpine Airways was discussed. Under the lease, the firm gets a portion of taxes, gas tax, and gross business. In answer to questions, the council learned from the board of supervisors that improvements at Mott include parking area, runway, landing lights, beacon light, and an 8 by 10 foot building. The county will not drill a well at the airport. Assessed value is \$103,250 and the airport is now taxed on \$23,750. It was estimated the airport would net the two cities \$700 annually. There will be a joint meeting on this at the Mount Shasta city hall June 4, at 7 p.m.

A resolution was passed employing Robert A. Bedford as radio dispatcher to take the place of Raymond Beghini who resigned. An agreement between the city and A. E. Kottinger S and N and Gravel was signed. Kottinger is to maintain and sprinkle the park road, make a gate and keep it locked except when in use, and repair any damage to park roads.

Sandra L. Lewis was employed in the city office and 15 major streets in town were named. Old McClelland Road, in South Mount Shasta annex was taken into the city. Pine Street was extended

Russians Fire Rocket Tests

MOSCOW (UPI) — The Soviet Union, in tests designed to boost its manned space program, has fired rockets nearly 7,500 miles into the central Pacific Ocean, Tass said today.

The Soviet news agency said the final stages of the rockets hit their target areas "with a high degree of accuracy."

The tests were carried out May 18 and 25, Tass said. It did not say how many rockets were fired.
