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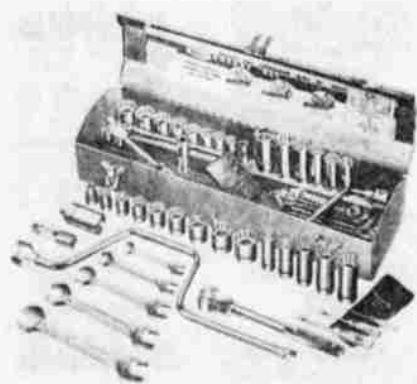

OREGON CITY (UPI)—A barnyard hen at Molalla has produced a world's record size egg.

The hen, owned by Mrs. Harvey Nelson, produced the huge egg last April 22. Its record size was established by the poultry department of Oregon State University.

The egg weighs 345 grams. The Molalla egg is 4.7 inches long and 2.33 inches in girth.

USDA Announces List Of Potato Committee

Members and alternates of the Oregon-California Potato Committee have been announced by the United States Department of Agriculture as nominated by the potato industry in those states.

The committee administers the federal marketing order regulating the handling of Irish potatoes grown in Modoc and Siskiyou counties in California and in all counties except Malheur in Oregon. The committee consists of eight producer members and four handler members, with an alternate for each member.

The USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service said the following members and alternates will serve from July 1, 1963 through June 30, 1965. Members and alternates are elected for two years, with terms of half of the members expiring each year.
