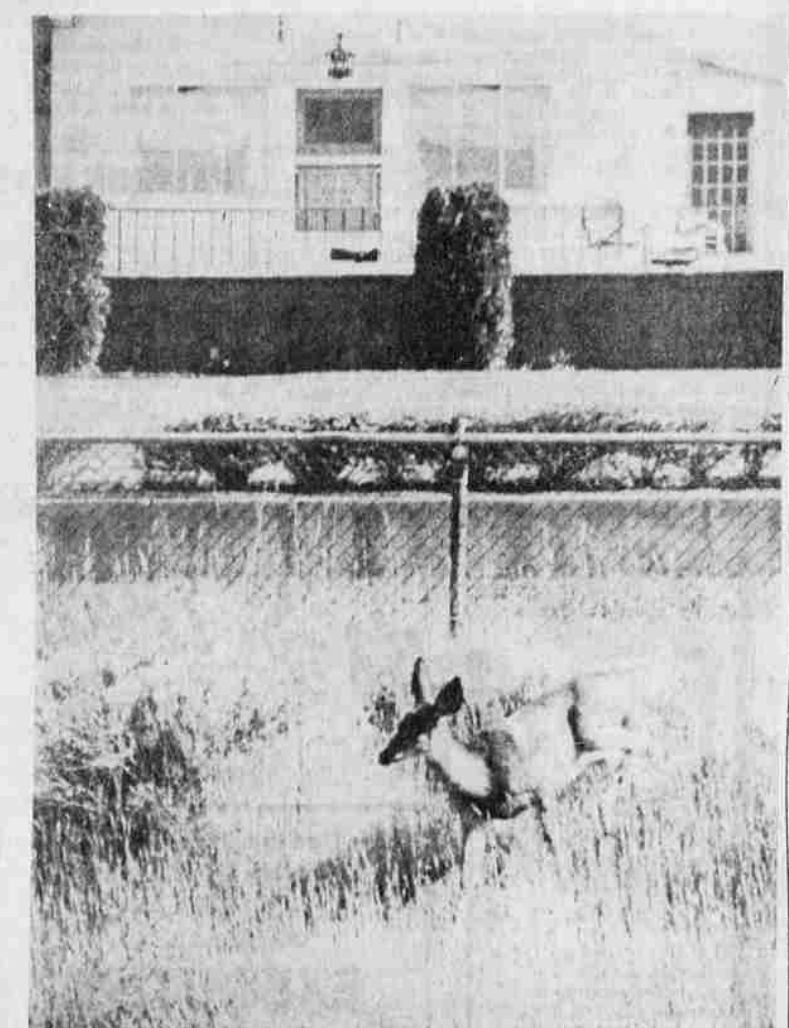

Higher State Income Taxes Scheduled For October Date

SALEM (UPI)—The \$46 million state income tax increase adopted by the 1963 legislature up the state tax 20 per cent. The federal deduction has been eliminated, but you can deduct the full amount of your higher state tax from your federal income tax return. This means a slightly lower federal tax, hence in effect Uncle Sam will be paying part of your higher state tax bill.

The new state income tax measure will become law Sept. 2, unless it is referred by the voters. If it is referred, the legislature has set aside \$300,000 and a date in October for a special election. Under the new tax measure, the familiar 1000 exemption is gone.

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State Employee Pay Raise Okayed By Legislature

SALEM (UPI)—Millions of dollars were allocated by the 1963 legislature for pay increases. State agency and department heads had their top pay upped from the \$120 a year increase received by the employment commissioner, to the \$210 a year hike received by the director of finance and administration. A total of \$12 million was set aside with the emergency board, made up of legislators, for increases in civil service and unclassified personnel pay rates.

The State Board of Higher Education received \$1,701,627 for pay raises for academic personnel.

Merit Raises Too

This money is in addition to automatic merit increases. The governor was raised \$1,500 to \$21,500 a year. In addition, he receives \$800 a month for expenses.

The secretary of state and state treasurer also received a \$1,500 pay increase, bringing their pay up to \$16,500 a year.

The attorney general and labor commissioner were raised \$1,000 a year to \$16,000.

Pay for the newly-created position of state fire marshal was set in at \$12,000 a year. The fire marshal was given the additional duties of superintendent of public instruction was unchanged, and still ranges from \$14,000 to \$17,000.

Salaries of state policemen were increased. The top pay for recruits was upped \$20 to a top of \$4,000.

Privates were upped \$10 to a top of \$5,000; privates first class up \$10 to \$6,000; corporals up \$10 to \$6,500; sergeants up \$50 to \$7,500; lieutenants up \$400 to \$8,500, and captains up \$800 to \$9,500.

Highest-paid state employee is Roy E. Linnell, chancellor of the State System of Higher Education, who receives \$26,000 a year plus a house, car and expense allowance. Next highest except for the governor are the superintendents of the state's mental hospitals, upped to a uniform \$10,000.
