WALL STREET CHATTER

NEW YORK (UPI) — Thomas McKinnon believes the market background favors further gains and that the current corrective phase should put the list in shape for a traditional summer rally next month.

However, the firm feels that opportunities will be highly selective and the knowing investor should continue to exercise the sound fundamentals of value and timing.

Goodbody & Co. says notwithstanding the possibility of a brief technical correction, there appears to be sound basis for confidence in the coming months.

Stanley Heller & Co. feels the promising outlook for the economy with prospects of increased corporate earnings and dividends should be reflected in a general uptrend of stock prices. The firm says equity purchases may prove rewarding if made during brief periods of technical reaction which may develop at various times.
