Sons Of Erin Rolling Carpet For President

DUBLIN (UPI) — They're rolling out the green carpet all over this Emerald Isle for the expected visit of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, a returning son of Erin whose great-grandfather set sail for the New World more than 100 years ago.

In the little river-port community of New Ross, in County Wexford, a special platform has been erected to ceremoniously welcome the President near the old cobblestone quay where young Patrick Kennedy left in the mid-19th Century.

New Ross, which will play host to the President during his planned stay June 26-29, is the most important town in the country today. But here in Dublin, in Cork, in Galway and in tiny villages throughout the country, the lulling is going up: "Cead mile faille" it says in Gaelic — "100,000 welcomes".

"It is going to be the greatest reception in living memory," said Andy Minihan, chief organizer of the New Ross welcome.

Ancestral Birthplace
Just about four miles from the ancient town lies the small cluster of houses known as Dunganstown where Mrs. Mary Ryan, a third cousin of the American President, is the proud keeper of the ancestral Kennedy birthplace.

It was from a tiny, red-painted little dwelling with a galvanized roof (where once there was a thatched covering) that young Patrick Kennedy set out for the immigrant ship. It was there President Kennedy forebears lived at the time the great potato famine decimated the Irish and drove them in tens of thousands to find a new life in the United States.

Mrs. Ryan loves to chat about her famous kinsman, whom she has met twice already, but she said she is not planning anything special for her next meeting.

"He knows what we are like and how we live and, somehow, I think he would be disappointed to find things all fussed up when he gets here," she said.

Closest Relatives
About a half mile down the twisting road from Dunganstown is a two-story house where James Kennedy and his wife live with their four children — Anna, Patrick, Peggy and Kitty.

James is Mary's brother and shares with her the honor of being the closest Irish relatives of the President, Kennedy, when he visited Ireland as a U.S. senator, succeeded in locating James and his family for a chat.

SAN FRANCISCO (UPI)—Mention the word "buttons" to representatives of the City of Hope hospital office here, and they get the glossy-eyed look of a punch-drunk fighter.

They're still reeling from a lesson they got early this year in the power of publicity.

It started when a button distributor, as his donation to a local fund raising sale for the City of Hope, gave them 1.2 million buttons.

Not knowing what to do with them, the City of Hope workers staged a contest—"What Shall We Do With 1.2 Million Buttons?" Word of the contest was circulated throughout the nation in a United Press International news dispatch.

And entries started pouring in. Finally, Jack Eschleman, public relations man for the City of Hope, contacted UPI.

"Tell the people they're wonderful," he said, "but please tell them the contest has been over for two months. We're still getting suggestions from all over the country."

The winner: Mrs. Gladys Soeth of Orland, Calif. She suggested that hospital patients turn the buttons into ornamental objects as therapy, the finished products then being sold to raise funds for the City of Hope medical and research programs.
