

Nation's Newest-Oldest Railroad Goes Into Operation In Redwood Grove

FELTON, Calif. (UPI) — The Big Trees Narrow Gauge Railroad (RC&BTNGRR), and it carries excursionists through the redwood groves of Santa Cruz County, about 70 miles south of San Francisco. Its maiden passenger-paying run was made on Palm Sunday this year.

Eventually, the road will curve more than 3½ miles from its starting terminal, then back on itself on a round trip to the top of Bear Mountain.

The coaches, built by H. A. Pulaski, Inc., of Irwindale, Calif., were used in the 1880's on the narrow gauge Nevada-California-Oregon Railroad along the eastern slopes of the Sierra Nevada. The rails were made in the same period for the long gone Carson & Colorado Railway. They originally came around the Horn on a sailing ship. The roadbed is laid on hand-split ties.

Valley Faces Smog Future

CORVALLIS (UPI) — In future years, the Willamette Valley could become a "smog land," according to an Oregon State University pilot study in meteorology.

A report by William P. Lowry said air pollution problems come about when air stagnates and high levels of pollutants build up. In the case of the Willamette Valley, air stagnation occurs often during the year.

The ring of hills around the valley restricts horizontal ventilation, and vertical ventilation is slowed by layers of air of different temperatures.

Lowry said that rain and winter winds probably will keep the valley free of pollution during the first half of the year, but the June-December period could bring conditions favorable for smog.

The level of pollutants emitted from industrial plants and automobiles is still relatively low, he said, but as population increases, smog will be a serious problem.

EXTENDS DEADLINE
CAIRO (UPI) — The Iraqi government has extended the deadline on its surrender ultimatum to Kurdish rebels in northern Iraq, the semi-official Middle East News Agency (MENA) said today.

Mena, quoting Baghdad Radio, said the deadline next Tuesday had been extended to June 30 "for those rebels who were not informed of the surrender order."

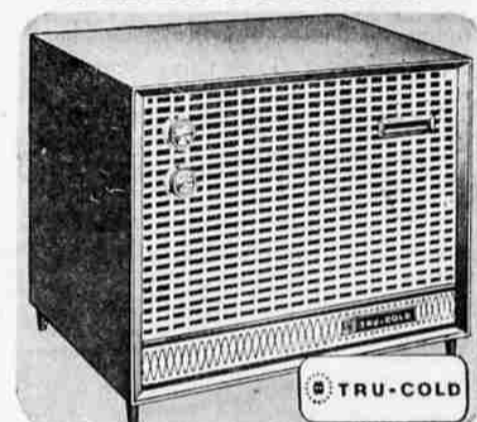

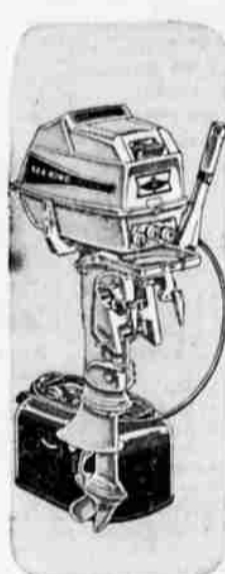
