Orphan of Civil Rights Storm Is 1960 Promises

The orphan of the 1963 civil rights storm is the 1960 campaign promise to prevent racial job discrimination by means of federal law supported by federal penalties.

A Fair Employment Practices Commission (FEPC) was not included in the civil rights legislation proposed to Congress this week by President Kennedy. In the message to Congress accompanying the proposed legislation, Kennedy did, however, endorse FEPC in this language:

"Finally, I renew my support of pending federal fair employment practices legislation, applicable to both employers and unions."

A House labor subcommittee made that endorsement look pretty good - better than it deserved - by voting on the same day to approve the pending FEPC bill cited by Kennedy. But the bill still has a long road to passage. Among other things it will need a House rules committee green light to reach the House floor. A similar bill died in rules last session.

FEPC Hot Issue

Kennedy's reference to the pending FEPC bill was not much more than lip service. He could not have done much less and he evidently did not dare do more. FEPC is the real time bomb buried in the civil rights package.

More than the integration of schools, swimming pools or lunch rooms, FEPC inflames southern whites against and Negroes in favor of its provisions.

It is not unlikely that the Kennedy administration is becoming a bit tender on the subject of the integrity of 1960 Democratic civil rights. The FEPC promise was explicit enough.

The new Democratic administration will support federal legislation establishing an FEPC to secure effectively for every one the right to equal opportunity for employment."

The Kennedy administration's support of FEPC has been more apparent than real. In any event, it has not been sufficient to obtain legislation. Nor is any FEPC legislation in prospect now, despite the President's kind words in his message to Congress.

Top Issue Sidelined

Only the most naive will fail to spot the plot whereby the Democrats in cautious compromise with the Republicans are maneuvering to sideline the most

hotly controversial of the civil rights propositions now proposed. The hottest of these is FEPC. They plot a device where FEPC is kept separate from the civil rights package so that other issues may not be swamped in the angry hurricane certain to arise around FEPC.

The same device is being used to bypass the private accommodations section of the Kennedy civil rights program. The Senate Republican and Democratic leaders are backing a substitute bill from which the Kennedy public accommodations section has been cast out. Public accommodations is another hot spot. Neither it nor FEPC is likely to pass.

The Republicans are linked with the FEPC because it was made so much more difficult to pass. The Democrats in 1960 had their fingers crossed.

Some of the Democratic platform, you might say, was just campaign oratory.

Plea Now Innocent

PORTLAND (UPI) - Federal Judge William G. East has allowed a former state penitentiary guard to change a guilty plea to innocent in connection with a charge involving sale of demerol, a synthetic narcotic.

Judge East said Roland B. Anderson, 31, Portland, after changing his plea from innocent to guilty Tuesday, has indicated by telephone he wanted to change his plea back to innocent. The judge said Anderson told him there had been a misunderstanding regarding the count, and that he objected to a word in the indictment.

Judge East said the eight counts which the court dropped Tuesday on recommendation by the U.S. attorney's office would be referred again to the grand jury.
