WHIPPED CREAM DRESSINGS

Salad Glamor
The United States Department of Agriculture, noting that milk production is at its seasonal peak, has named milk and dairy products the Plentiful-Foods-to-Feature for the week June 30-July 6.

One of the dairy products, popular with everyone because it's good and it's glamorous, is whipping cream. Think what it does to the flavor and eye appeal of strawberry shortcake, for example!

It also adds a zesty, festive note to salads made with the colorful fresh fruits and vegetables which the Agricultural Marketing Service reports are now on hand in abundant supply. Simply begin with a basic dressing and vary it to suit the salad. Like this:

BASIC WHIPPED CREAM DRESSING

Quickly whip 1/2 cup heavy cream (in a well-chilled bowl with a well-chilled beater) until stiff, adding 2 tablespoons lemon juice or vinegar, 1/4 teaspoon salt and a few grains pepper when the cream is partially whipped. This insures uniform flavoring and prevents over-whipping. Makes 1 cup dressing.

California Cream Dressing
Fold in 1 tablespoon each chopped dates, figs and raisins. Serve with fresh fruit combinations.

Anchovy Cream Dressing
Wash, dry and finely mince 3 anchovy fillets; add with 1 teaspoon grated lemon rind to basic dressing after other flavorings.

Cucumber Cream Dressing
Fold in 1/2 cup pared, finely-diced, well-drained cucumber. Adds an elegant note to seafood or tomato salads.

Horseradish Cream Dressing
Fold in 2 teaspoons grated bottled horseradish and omit lemon juice called for in basic recipe. Serve with ham or beef main dish salads.

Ginger Cream Dressing
Add 1 teaspoon chopped, candied ginger and 1 teaspoon grated lemon rind. Serve with fresh fruit or molded fruit salads.

For a hard-to-clean blackened aluminum pan, boil a solution of one tablespoon of cream of tartar and one quart of water in the pan.

JELLIED MEAT LOAF

(6 servings)

- 1 envelope unflavored gelatin
- 1/2 cup cold water
- 3/4 cup boiling tomato juice or water
- 1/4 cup vinegar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 2 cup cooked beef, finely diced
- 1/2 cup celery, diced
- 1/2 cup pimento, chopped
- 1/4 cup green pepper, chopped
- 1/4 cup onion, minced
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 2 hard-cooked eggs, sliced
- Lettuce, shredded

Soften gelatin in cold water; dissolve in hot liquid. Stir in vinegar and salt; chill until syrupy. Combine remaining ingredients except eggs. Arrange egg slices along bottom and sides of loaf pan. Combine gelatin and meat mixtures; mix thoroughly. Turn into loaf pan and chill until firm. Serve cold on shredded lettuce.

ROAST BEEF SALAD

- 1 egg, hard-cooked, chilled
- 3 cup cold roast beef cubes
- 1/4 cup quick meat broth (1 beef bouillon cube dissolved in one cup boiling water)

LAZY DAY

For a Friday special, serve a hearty open-faced sandwich. Stir husky ripe olive wedges into hot cheese sauce. Spread mashed California avocado on toasted bread. Top with sliced tomato and cheese-olive sauce.
