Answers: 1. You—u; 2. the conductor minds the train, and the teacher trains the mind; 3. the sheriff.

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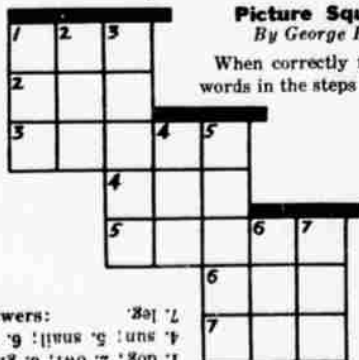
