3 Records Of Vatican Paint Colorful Picture

ROME (UPI) — Martin Haley, a St. Paul, Minn., public relations man, has done what many would consider impossible — he has "recorded" the Vatican.

"If they can put auto races on stereophonic records, why can't we do it with the Vatican?" is his reply to how it was done. But he is quick to add that "maybe I wouldn't have done it if I'd known how much work it involved."

Haley (of 442 Summit Ave., St. Paul) has succeeded admirably in doing the impossible. The three-hour, three-LP record series called "The Sounds Of The Vatican" paints a sound portrait that nobody who has ever paid even a brief visit to the 108-acre state can fail to recognize.

There is everything: the bells of St. Peter's Basilica, the cacophony of a traffic jam, a solemn pontifical mass, roll call and changing of the Swiss Guard, the tiny Vatican Fire Department during a fire drill, and even the daily, early morning traffic passing into the Vatican through the St. Ann gateway.

Great Recordings And the recordings also show the great, open personality of the late Pope John XXIII. Haley explained that he had set up microphones in the Clementine Hall inside the Apostolic Palace to record the Pontiff during his regular Wednesday general audiences.

"On this particular Wednesday the crowd was so great that many of them were unable to get inside the Clementine Hall and remained in another, nearby room. All of them were afraid they wouldn't be able to see Pope John."

"Instead, Pope John on his way to the Clementine Hall noticed the overflow. He went into the adjoining room and told the people everything that he was going to say to the Clementine Hall, just to make certain."

"On that occasion we were lucky because microphones were in the room and had been turned up for testing. As a result, we recorded everything the pontiff said."

"But, on other occasions, it was just plain work that enabled us to get what we did. We spent hours upon hours placing the microphones before such important ceremonies as the closing of the Ecumenical Council and canonization ceremonies a few days later."

Want Better Seats

"During the closing session of the Council a group of nuns decided they wanted to get into a better position. Ignoring police and a solid mass of people they moved in a phalanx across St. Peter's Basilica."

Never Rescue Your Partner

If bridge players had to pass a life saving test before they were allowed to rescue their partner's it would probably improve their game.

Certainly, if South had given himself such a test he would have let his partner struggle with two spades and not dived into the hopeless two no-trump contract.

West opened the ten of spades. East signaled with the eight and West was able to read that as a suit preference because obviously West could not expect ever to run a spade suit. Hence West made a mental note to lead his deuce of hearts whenever he got in.

South cashed a second spade and discarded a heart while West let a club go. Then South led a diamond from dummy and finessed his jack. West won and in accordance with his early note led that deuce of hearts.

East won with the queen and led his four of hearts to his partner's nine. West cashed his ace and promptly led a low club.

West had no worries about this lead. His partner had doubled both two spades and two no-trump and had shown up with the jack of spades, the king-queen of hearts and nothing in diamonds. So he was marked with the ace of clubs!

East won the club, cashed his king of hearts and led a club to give his partner two more club tricks. Down three!

Not bad when you note that it would have taken perfect defense to beat two spades just one trick.

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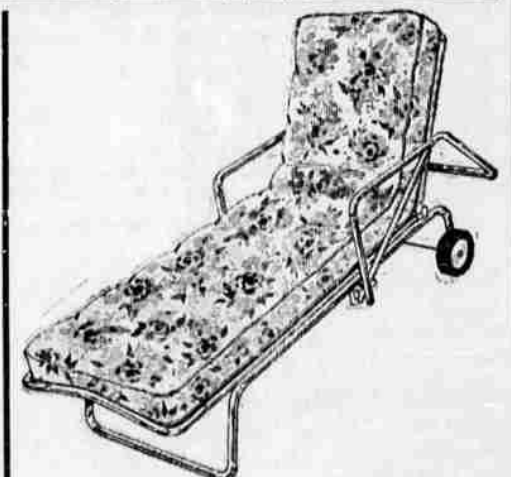
