

KBAA's Summer Track Program Gets Underway

The Klamath Basin Athletic Association's summer track program got underway at Modoc Field Tuesday afternoon with three events being run off under age brackets and with some 35 participants taking part in the opening events.

There were three events run off Tuesday and Thursday's meet will include the broad jump and high jump. There will be meets every Tuesday and Thursday so athletes wishing to take part can keep watching this sports section for word of when his or her special event is coming up.

This was the first phase of the summer program which the KBAA hopes to conclude with taking a team to the Emerald Empire Athletic Association (EAAA) meet in Eugene in August. One big meet before that time is hoped for. But records established in the weekly program will all be new records for the holders.

The records established Tuesday were the first ones and the remainder will be records until broken. The first KBAA undertaking was run under age divisions which had too wide a margin of ages. Kids in this program run with kids their own age so as to have a better chance.

The events run Tuesday were the 60, 100 and 220-yard dashes. Records were established in the 60 and 100-yard dashes and all

Clay Will Get Offer Sept. 30

NEW YORK (UPI) — Cassius Clay will be presented with a million-dollar "take it or leave it" offer today to meet heavyweight champion Sonny Liston at Philadelphia Stadium Sept. 30.

The offer will be made by Bob Nilon, a Chester, Pa., businessman and brother of Jack Nilon, Liston's adviser, who planned to meet here today with Bill Faversham, head of the 11-man group guiding the destiny of Clay.

Bob Nilon revealed in Philadelphia Tuesday night the details of the offer, which presumably rest on Liston retaining his title in his rematch with Floyd Patterson at Las Vegas July 22. "This is the greatest offer ever made to a challenger," he said. "If Clay turns it down, it means he'll be turning his back on better than a million-dollar offer."

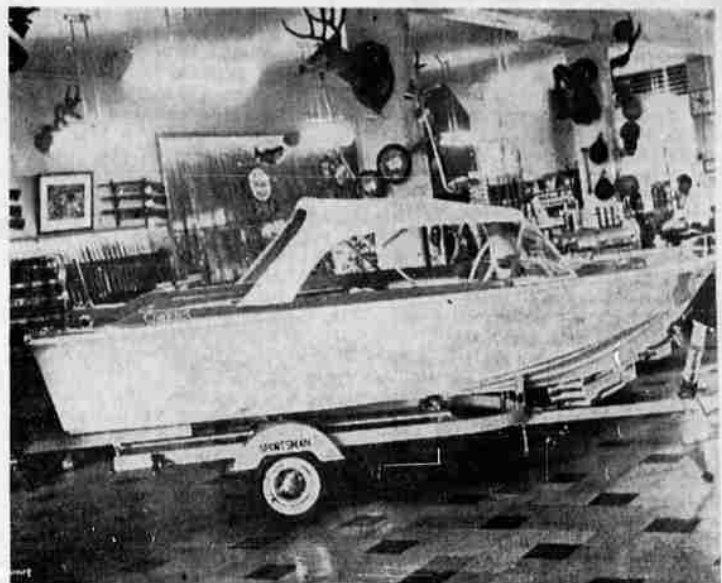

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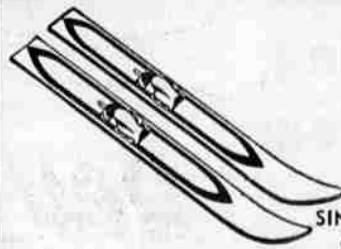
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Persons who received an antelope tag for 1961 or 1962 are not eligible to apply in 1963.
