

'Mended Heart Club' In Pakistan Is One Of Most Unique Throughout The World

KARACHI (UPI)—More than 40 Pakistanis recently became members of one of the most unusual heart clubs in the world when a six-member team of American heart specialists finished a mission in Pakistan.

Official membership cards and pins of the "Mended Heart Club," were distributed by Dr. Joan Coggin, Hollywood, Calif., to 44 Pakistanis who successfully underwent open heart surgery to correct defects that would otherwise have shortened or restricted their lives.

Dr. Coggin was the cardiologist on the team from Loma Linda University and White Memorial Hospital in Los Angeles, Calif. The team was led by Dr. Ellisworth E. Wareham (2201 Hill Drive) Los Angeles, who is associate professor of surgery at Loma Linda University.

Dr. Coggin purchased the pins, which are red hearts with a gold scar across them, at her own expense before leaving the United States on the month-long mission. First to receive a pin was Ashan Zafar, three-year-old daughter of Z. A. K. Zafar of Karachi, said.

Swim Pool Assured

MOUNT SHASTA—A swimming pool is assured for Mount Shasta with the additional gift of \$1,000 from Mrs. Harry L. Benton of La Jolla, which brings the cash balance for the Harry L. Benton Memorial Swimming Pool up to \$7,600, according to George Thebolt, chairman of the swimming pool commission.

In addition to the \$7,600, the commission has the equipment for the filter system and other equipment which makes the total assets about \$20,000.

The commission plans to build the pool so it will be available for use next summer. It will be located on Siskiyou Union High School district ground, behind Mount Shasta High School, and will be a 25 meter pool.

Members of the swimming pool commission are appointed, two by the high school district board and three by the city council. Members besides Thebolt are James Herbert of McCloud, Donald Ratley, Larry Wisner and L. W. Kellogg.

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
